

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF SALE

TERMS

Net 30 days to those with established accounts, otherwise cash, debit card or credit card. Interest is charged at the rate of 5% per month on overdue accounts. Overdue accounts will automatically turn over to COD until brought back to current standing. Customers not making annual purchases will be requested to re-apply for an account. Accounts that do less than \$1000 business in one season will be turned over to COD terms. All accounts must be paid by the end of the season or will be subject to a 5% per month late payment charge.

GUARANTEE

All stock is guaranteed true to name. Seller gives no other warrantee, expressed or implied. Condition, growth and production after pick up or delivery is the responsibility of the buyer. No returns.

HOLDING POLICY

Confirmed orders placed with Foxglove Wholesale Nursery will be held at no charge for a maximum of 30 days. After 30 days, a 50%, non-refundable deposit will be charged to continue holding material, otherwise plants will be returned to stock. Additional maintenance holding fees may be charged depending on length of time plants are to be held.

SHIPPING

All goods travel at purchaser's risk and expense. After goods are delivered to forwarders, our responsibility ceases. Customers who give us no shipping instructions agree to let us use the carrier of our choice, without responsibility on our part. Freight charges will be invoiced by Foxglove Wholesale Nursery at time of shipment and are due on receipt. A Foxglove Wholesale Nursery delivery truck is available at an hourly rate for delivery. COD account holders must pay for orders prior to shipping.

PICK UP ORDERS

Customers picking up their orders are required to give us at least 48 hours notice prior to pick up. Please ensure you arrive with tarps or other suitable coverings to protect your plants on your truck as even a short trip without proper care can kill nursery stock.

PRICES

Our prices are wholesale trade only and are subject to change without notice. Prices may vary depending on sources. All prices quoted are F.O.B. Foxglove Wholesale Nursery locations.

CLAIMS

Nursery stock is to be inspected by the purchaser on receipt. All claims must be made within 2 business days.

ROYALTIES

CANCELLATIONS

A re-stocking fee of 35% will be applied for any cancelled orders in progress /prepared in our shipping dock. The buyer may not cancel this order unless such cancellation is expressly agreed to in writing by the seller. SEMPERVIVUM



Hens & Chicks - An evergreen, mat-forming succulent. Requires well-drained soil, but otherwise thrives on neglect. Great for xeriscaping. Grows 3-6" tall x 6-12" wide. **Zone 3.**

STACHYS BYZANTINA



'HELEN VON STEIN' Lamb's Ear - Velvety silvery-green foliage provides great texture. Great heat tolerance. Leaves are twice the size of other cultivars. Grows 10" tall x 18" apart. **Zone 4.**

THYMUS



THYMUS PSEUDOLANUGINOSUS Woolly Thyme - Amazing smelling with woolly gray-green foliage. Excellent for use between flagstones or in a rock garden. Tiny pink flowers bloom in late spring. Grows 6" tall x 3' wide. **Zone 3.**

THYMUS PRAECOX 'ALBIFLORUS' White Creeping Thyme - Fragrant light-green leaves, smothered by star-shaped white flowers in summer. Grows 1-2" tall x 12-18" wide. **Zone 2.**

THYMUS SERPYLLUM 'ELFIN' Creeping Thyme - Dainty silver-green foliage adds character to rock gardens, and provides an interesting texture to pathways. Small purple blooms appear in late spring. Salt tolerant. Grows to 4" high and spreading. **Zone 4.**

VERONICA SPICATA



'ROYAL CANDLES' Spike Speedwell - Forms a low bushy mound of dark green leaves, bearing short spikes of bright blue flowers in early summer for several weeks. A vigorous upright grower. Grows 15-18" tall x 15" wide. **Zone 4.**

VINCA MINOR



'LA GRAVE' Periwinkle - Violet-blue flowers bloom on this evergreen ground cover in May or June. Performs best in rich, evenly moist, well drained soil. Can handle full sun to full shade. Grows 6-8" tall and spreads many feet. **Zone 4.**

ACER GINNALA



Amur Maple - A graceful shrub or small tree with slender branches. Delicate leaves are medium green with brilliant orange to bright red autumn color. Grows 15 ft. high with equal spread. **Zone 3.**

AMELANCHIER ALNIFOLIA



Saskatoon/ Serviceberry - Works well in a natural setting, fruit is edible, tolerates harsh climates and alkaline soil. Single white blossoms in spring. Grows 10 -15 ft. high with equal spread. **Zone 2.**

ARCTOSTAPHYLOS UVA URSI



Kinnikinnick- Outstanding evergreen groundcover that does best in sandy infertile soils. Very salt tolerant. Has small pink flowers followed by bright red fruit. Grows to 6 inches high, spreads well. **Zone 2.**

AZALEA 'NORTHERN LIGHTS' Series

A hardy series of hybrid Azaleas.

BERBERIS THUNBERGII



'AUREA NANA' Golden Dwarf Barberry - A dense, compact shrub. Its small, attractive, golden-green leaves turn orange-yellow in the fall. Bright red berries which are attractive to birds, appear in late summer to fall and persist into winter. Grows 2-3' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

'CHERRY BOMB' Barberry - Compact branches make a great low hedge, deep crimson foliage. Grows 3-4' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

'CONCORD' Barberry - A tidy ball with velvety, deep purple foliage. Grows 18 inches tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

'ROSE GLOW' Barberry - Spectacular shrub with mottled red, green, white & pink leaves. Has bright red berries in fall which persist through winter. Does best in full sun. Grows 5-6' tall with similar width. **Zone 3.**

'ROYAL BURGUNDY' Gentry Barberry - Velvet-like rich burgundy color foliage, darkens to even richer hues in fall. Bright red berries. Tidy compact form with spreading habit is versatile for filling out planting areas in group or masses. Full sun. Moderate grower to just 2' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 4.**

'RUBY CAROUSEL' Bailone Barberry - A low rounded, red leafed barberry with excellent uniformity. A great choice for low hedges or foundation plantings. Full sun. Grows 3-4' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 4.**

BUDDLEIA DAVIDII



'BUZZ VELVET' Butterfly Bush - Spiked blooms are magenta, purple, & blush, with a warm orange centre. These 6-8" blooms last from May through September. Requires full sun. Grows 3-5' tall x 2-3' wide. **Zone 5.**

'BLACK KNIGHT' Butterfly Bush - This is the darkest flowering variety, almost a grape violet, & sweetly fragrant. Blooms from early summer through fall. Requires full sun. Grows 6-8'tall x 4'-6' wide. **Zone 5.**

SAGINA SUBULATA



'AUREA' Scotch Moss - Forms a very low, moss-like carpet of evergreen yellow foliage. Tiny, translucent white flowers appear in spring. Great for in between paving stones & walkways, as it can handle moderate foot traffic. Grows up to 1" tall x 6-12" wide. **Zone 3.**

SALVIA



'CARADONNA' Meadow Sage - Vertical spikes of dark purple to violet-blue flowers in late spring or early summer. Grey-green clumped aromatic foliage. Remove spent flowers to promote further blooms. Grows 1-2' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

'LYRICAL WHITE' Meadow Sage - Pure white flower spikestop grey-green foliage. Deadhead to promote longer blooming season. Grows 21-23" tall x 21-23" wide. **Zone 4.**

'MAY NIGHT' Meadow Sage - Blooms prolifically with deep purple-blue flowers. Blooming in late spring with a profusion of flower spikes, it reblooms later in the summer when dead-headed. Salt tolerant. Grows 1.5-2' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

SEDUM



'ANGELINA' Stonecrop - Vibrant yellow, needle-like foliage forms a quick groundcover. Semi-evergreen that needs good drainage. Grows 4-6" tall x 1-2' wide. **Zone 3.**

'AUTUMN JOY' Stonecrop - Upright, green succulent foliage. Blooms pink in August, turning to salmon, then dusty red. Excellent dried flower. Leave flower heads uncut for winter interest. Grows up to 2' tall x 2' wide. **Zone 4.**

'DRAGON'S BLOOD' Stonecrop - Red-margined, green leaves become brilliantly red with cool autumn temperatures. Clustered star-shaped pink flowers in summer. Fast growing 4-6" tall x 2' wide. **Zone 4.**

SUNSPARKLER® 'FIRECRACKER' Stonecrop - Bright plum-purple foliage is contrasted with pink flowers from late summer to fall. Salt tolerant. Grows 6" tall x 1-1.5' wide. **Zone 4.**

SUNSPARKLER® 'LIME ZINGER' Stonecrop - Lime green succulent leaves are contrasted by star-shaped pink flowers appearing in late summer. Grows 4" tall x 18" wide. **Zone 4.**

PERENNIALS

PACHYSANDRA TERMINALIS



Japanese Spurge - Spreading evergreen perennial with dark green leaves. Tiny white flowers bloom in early summer. Good for groundcover in woodland gardens, or slope erosion. Full to partial shade. Grows 6" tall x 1-1.5' wide. **Zone 5.**

PHLOX SUBULATA



Creeping Phlox - A carpet of flowers, excellent for a groundcover or accent, perfect for banks. Evergreen foliage. Grows 6 inches tall x 3' wide. **Zone 3.**

Scarlet Flame, Crimson Beauty, Emerald Cushion Blue, Emerald Pink, Purple Beauty, & White Delight

PEROVSKIA ATRIPLICIFOLIA



Russian Sage - Silvery-green foliage with lavender purple flowers from summer to frost. Left uncut, foliage is attractive in winter. Blooms from July to Oct. Cut plants almost to the ground in late winter or early spring to prevent floppy stems. Air pollution tolerant. Grows 3-5' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 4.**

'LITTLE SPIRE' Russian Sage - Violet-blue spikes, fragrant silvery foliage. This cultivar was selected for its relatively short, up-right habit which prevents the leaning that is typical of the species. Wonderfully long blooming period from late summer to fall. Salt tolerant. Grows to 1.5-2' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

RUDBECKIA FULDIGA



'LITTLE GOLDSTAR' Dwarf Black Eyed Susan - Masses of 2-2.5" blooms - up to 80 per mature plant - from mid-summer through fall. Great heat tolerance. Deadhead to promote more blooms. Grows 14-16" tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

'GOLDSTURM' Black Eyed Susan - Brilliant golden daisy flowers with black, coned centers that remain and give winter interest. Great in mass plantings, borders, and as cut flowers. Long bloom period. Grows 24-30" tall x 18-23" wide. **Zone 3.**

BUXUS MICROPHYLLA



'WINTER GEM' Boxwood - Glossy leaved, densely branched shrub with bright green new spring growth. Round foliage turns bronze in winter. Excellent hedging plant. Urban pollution tolerant. Plant 1-1.5' on centre for a formal hedge. Grows 2-3' tall x 2-3' wide. **Zone 5.**

BUXUS X



'GREEN GEM' Boxwood - Noted for its globular shape and excellent winter hardiness. Small, round leaves retain dark green colour in winter. Finer textured than other boxwoods. Plant 2 feet apart on centre for a formal hedge. Grows 3 feet tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

'GREEN MOUNTAIN' Boxwood - An upright, naturally cone-shaped habit makes this cultivar great for topiary, container planting, specimen, or hedging. Can tolerate clay soils but prefers well-drained soils. Grows 5' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 4.**

'GREEN VELVET' Boxwood - Superb low growing boxwood. Needs little pruning. Compact form with small leaves. Ideal for hedges & borders. Foliage retains rich green colour throughout winter. Plant 2-3 feet on centre for a formal hedge. Grows 3-4' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

CARYOPTERIS



'BEYOND MIDNIGHT' Bluebeard - Dark glossy foliage with a compact habit. Blue flowers bloom on new wood in late summer. Requires sun, & well-drained soil, but does not require deadheading. Grows 24-30" tall & wide. **Zone 5.**

'SUNSHINE BLUE II' Bluebeard - Bright yellow foliage with improved winter hardiness. Blue flowers produce in late spring through autumn. Grows 2-3' tall & wide. **Zone 5.**

CORNUS ALBA/ SERICEA/ STOLONIFERA



'ELEGANTISSIMA' Silver Variegated Dogwood - Provides a long season of interest with its variegated leaves, attractive berries, and showy red stems. Urban pollution & wet feet tolerant. Grows 8' tall x 5' wide. **Zone 2.**



'FARROW' Arctic Fire Red Dogwood - Rich red stems in fall through winter and early spring. Compact and non-suckering. Can tolerate wet feet. Grows 3-4' tall with equal width. **Zone 3.**



'ARCTIC FIRE YELLOW' Dogwood - an improved form of yellow-twig dogwood that has better branching and compact growth. Bright yellow stems create a striking display in winter or spring. Grows 4-5' tall & wide. **Zone 2.**

'IVORY HALO' Bailhalo Tatarian Dogwood - Bright red stems with variegated leaves. Does not spread as aggressively as red-twig dogwood. Can handle wet feet. Summer berries attract birds. Grows 4-6' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**

'RED OSIER' Red Twig Dogwood - Bright red stems, eye-catching in winter setting. Excellent for mass plantings. Berries attract birds. Wet feel tolerant. Grows 8' tall x 5'- 10' wide. **Zone 3.**

COTINUS COGGYRIA



'WINECRAFT BLACK' Smoke Bush - leaves emerge rich purple but as summer's heat comes on, they turn a deep near-black tone, and finally light up in an array of reds and oranges in fall. Unlike other smoke bush, it naturally has a rounded, dwarf habit which means that finally, every landscape has room for this unique plant. Grows 4-6' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**



'WINECRAFT GOLD' Smoke Bush - selected for its orange-red new growth in spring and improved burn resistance. Green flower plumes age to pink. Grows 4-6' tall & wide. **Zone 5.**



LEUCANTHEMUM X SUPERBUM



'BECKY' Shasta Daisy- Large white single blooms that continue longer when deadheaded. Sturdy flowers remain attractive even after a hard rain. Foliage grows 1' tall x 2' wide, with flowers reaching 2-3' tall. **Zone 5.**

'REAL SUNBEAM' Shasta Daisy - Tight clumping habit with bright yellow flowers, surrounding a large golden centre. Deadhead to encourage continuous blooms. Grows 18-20" tall x 18-23" wide. **Zone 5.**

'SNOWCAP' Dwarf Shasta Daisy - Large white daisy flowers that bloom from early to late summer. Remove spent blooms to encourage re-blooming. Good soil drainage is critical. Grows 10-14" tall x 12" wide. **Zone 5.**

MONARDA



'JACOB CLINE' Bee Balm - Enormous, vibrant red, fragrant, globular flowers. Blooms mid-summer to early fall. Mildew resistant. Cut to ground after flowering. Grows 3-4' tall x 1-2' wide. **Zone 4.**

MATTEUCCIA STRUTHIOPTERIS

Ostrich Fern - Clump forming, upright- arching, feathery foliage. Requires part shade to full shade. Great for rain gardens as it can tolerate standing water. Grows 3-6' tall x 5' wide. **Zone 3.**

NEPETA



'BLUE WONDER' Catmint- Dark blue flowers bloom from May to September. Fragrant grey-green foliage grows in a bushy mound. Tolerant of air pollution. May self-seed in ideal conditions. Grows 9"-1' x 1-2' wide. **Zone 3.**

'WALKERS LOW' Catmint- Lovely blue flowers accent aromatic grey-green foliage. Long season of bloom from April to September, with a carefree habit. May self-seed in ideal conditions. Salt tolerant. Grows 24" tall x 36" wide. **Zone 3.**

PERENNIALS

IRIS SIBERICA



'BUTTER & SUGAR' Siberian Iris- This mid- sized clump forming selection has bi-color, spring flowering buttery-yellow & white flowers. Great for ponds, rain gardens, banks & erosion control. Grows 24-30" tall & wide. **Zone 2.**

'CAESAR'S BROTHER' Siberian Iris - Intense blue flowers in late spring into summer. Slightly bluish green leaves. Great for ponds, rain gardens, banks & erosion control. Prefers moist soil. Grows 36-42" tall x 18-24" wide. **Zone 3.**

'RUFFLED VELVET' Siberian Iris - Deep purple ruffled flowers have yellow veins at base. Blooms late spring to early summer. Tolerant of urban pollution. Grows 2-3' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**

LAVANDULA ANGUSTIFOLIA



'HIDCOTE' English Lavender - Best color of all lavenders. Strong spikes of lavender blue flowers in summer above silvery grey-green foliage. Up to 3 blooms per season if dead-headed. Grows 15-18" tall x 1-2' wide. **Zone 5.**

'MINI BLUE' English Lavender- Compact grey-green foliage, strong stems and flower spikes of vivid purple/ blue. Long blooming. Grows 10-12" tall x 10" wide. **Zone 5.**

'MUNSTEAD' English Lavender - Compact and early flowering. Rosy-purple blooms. Blooms twice starting in late spring or early summer. This is a fragrant robust lavender and, due to its short size and tightly held blooms, makes a great hedge. Grows 12-18" tall & wide. **Zone 5.**

'SUPER BLUE' English Lavender - Deep blue flowers on short stems top green foliage. Extremely compact. Urban pollution tolerant. Grows 10-12" tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

COTONEASTER



DAMMERI 'CORAL BEAUTY' - Evergreen, fast growing ground cover with oval, glossy, bright green leaves and bright red fruit. This plant prefers well drained acidic soil that is slightly rocky. Grows 1 - 2' tall x 6' wide. **Zone 5.**

'LUCIDUS' Hedging Cotoneaster - Lustrous dark green leaves with yellow red combinations in the fall. Excellent for hedges, screening or in group plantings for color. Grows 9' tall x 7' wide. **Zone 2.**

EUONYMUS ALATUS



'COMPACTA' Dwarf-Winged Burning Bush- This dense, vase-shaped shrub displays striking fall colour. Great as a specimen, shrub border, or an informal hedge. Grows 8-10' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

WINGED Burning Bush - Excellent in hedges, groups or as a specimen plant. Winged bark adds to the winter landscape. Fall color is exceptional red. Grows 8' tall x 8' wide. **Zone 3.**

'FIREBALL' Burning Bush - Compact burning bush with tighter branching and superior stem hardiness. Grows 5-7' tall x 3-4' wide. **Zone 4.**



EUONYMUS FORTUNEI

'EMERALD GAIETY' Wintercreeper - Semi-evergreen with deep green foliage margined with white. A low growing shrub with a tight branching habit. Grows 4' tall x 4' wide. Will also climb walls and structures. **Zone 5.**

'EMERALD 'N' GOLD' Wintercreeper - Semi-evergreen with deep green foliage margined with yellow. Low growing & tight branching habit. Grows 2' tall x 4' wide. **Zone 5.**

EUONYMUS TURKESTANICA

'TURKESTAN' Burning Bush - An attractive semi-evergreen dwarf plant with narrow leaves with slightly weeping branches. Flowers pink seed capsules in spring. It has an upright form with a sprawling habit. Fall color is pinkish-red. Grows 3' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 3.**

FORSYTHIA



'NORTHERN GOLD' - Earliest blooming forsythia. Very hardy. Useful as a shrub and in massing and groupings. Grows 7' tall x 7' wide. **Zone 4.**

X INTERMEDIA 'SHOW OFF STARLET' - This dwarf forsythia is a mass of bright yellow spring flowers from base to tip. Improved flower display compared to older varieties. Grows 2'-3' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**



HIBISCUS



'LIL KIM' - Say hello to the first dwarf Rose of Sharon! Lil Kim is unique little shrub with showy white flowers punctuated with a showy red eye. Blooms all summer. Salt tolerant. Grows 3'-4' tall & wide. **Zone 5.**



'LIL KIM RED' - This newest addition to the Lil' Kim series has a compact habit and rich, deep rosy-red flowers. Grows 3'-4' tall & wide. **Zone 5.**



'LIL KIM VIOLET' - It has the same compact habit but with plum-violet flowers accented by a red eye. Grows 3'-4' tall & wide. **Zone 5.**



'BLUE CHIFFON' Rose of Sharon - Large, single, blue flowers have fluffy centres. Blooms all summer through fall on new wood. Salt tolerant. Grows 8-12' tall x 4-6' wide. **Zone 5.**



'PURPLE PILLAR' Columnar Rose of Sharon - Semi-double purple blooms, with reddish eye. Blooms summer through frost on new wood. Rarely requires pruning. Does best in full sun with good drainage. Requires patience due to late emergence from dormancy. Great for hedges, screens, & specimen plantings. Grows 10-15' tall x 2-3' wide. **Zone 5.**



'WHITE PILLAR' Columnar Rose of Sharon - Pure white, semi-double blooms. Blooms summer through frost on new wood. Rarely requires pruning. Does best in full sun with good drainage. Requires patience due to late emergence from dormancy. Great for hedges, screens, & specimen plantings. Grows 10-15' tall x 2-3' wide. **Zone 5.**



HEUCHERA



'PALACE PURPLE' Coral Bells - Low mound of maple-shaped leaves, from bronzy-green to a rich purple-red. Spikes of creamy-white flowers appear in early summer. Prefers partial shade. Salt tolerant. Grows 1-2' tall x 12-18" wide. **Zone 4.**

'FOREVER PURPLE' Coral Bells - Ultra-purple glossy foliage with fluted edges. Tiny purple-pink flowers on burgundy stems. Great heat tolerance. Evergreen. Grows 1-2' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**



'FOREVER RED' Coral Bells - The reddest heuchera on the market! Colour is most vibrant in cooler temperatures of spring & fall. Improved crown. Slightly ruffled, evergreen leaves on deep red stems. White flowers in mid-summer. Grows 14" tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

HOSTA



'BLUE ANGEL' Hosta - Dark blue-grey to blue-green leaves are 16" long. Drought tolerant once established. Slug resistant. Grows 3' tall x 5-6' wide. **Zone 3.**

'GUACAMOLE' Hosta - Apple green foliage is bordered by dark green margins. Sun tolerant with adequate moisture. Fragrant white blooms. Grows 1-2' tall x 4-5' wide. **Zone 3.**

'MALEPARTUS' Chinese Silver Grass - Green blades with white midribs, turn shades of red, orange, & bronze in fall. Large, pink-tinged, feathery plumes in late summer, earlier than most Miscanthus. Plumes turn coppery-red in fall, & silvery in winter. Salt tolerant. Clump forming. Grows 5-7' tall x 3-4' wide. **Zone 5.**

'PURPURASCENS' Flame Grass - Easily grown in average soil in full sun to light shade. Spectacular late season bloomer. Foliage turns flame-orange & bronze, to burgundy, with white plumes that persist through winter. Air pollution tolerant. Clump forming, reaching 4-5' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 4.**

PANICUM VIRGATUM



'HEAVY METAL' Blue Switch Grass - Metallic blue foliage with stiff vertical habit. Pinkish airy panicles in summer. Blades turns yellow in fall. Great for rain gardens. Grows 4-5' tall x 1-2' wide. **Zone 3.**

'HOT ROD' Red Switch Grass - Blue-green foliage during the growing season turns a deep burgundy-red in summer, earlier than any other Panicum. Airy seed heads provide winter interest. Salt tolerant. Clump-forming. Grows 3-4' tall x 2' wide. **Zone 3.**

GRASSES

WARM SEASON GRASSES

Grasses from warm climates come into growth in late spring, flower after mid-summer, & are usually cut back in late fall. They are best planted or divided in late spring.

BOUTELOUA GRACILIS



Mosquito/ Blue Grama Grass - Compact foliage forms a mound of blue-grey, narrow blades. Tan, brush-like plumes turn pinkish with frost, & white over winter. Requires good drainage. Grows 1-2' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**

HAKONECHLOA MACRA



'AUREOLA' Japanese Forest Grass - One of the most eye-catching small grasses, forming elegant arching clumps of vividly striped, bright gold & lime-green foliage that holds its color throughout the season. In full sun this cultivar often develops a slight reddish tinge. Prefers partial shade. Air pollution tolerant. Grows 12-18" tall & wide. **Zone 5.**

IMPERATA CYLINDRICA



'RED BARON' Japanese Blood Grass - A great red tipped, upright grass that becomes increasingly red as the season progresses. Becomes blood red by fall. Best colour in full sun. It is useful in borders, rock gardens, containers or as a colorful accent. Grows 18" tall x 36" wide, spreading by shallow moving rhizomes. **Zone 5.**

SHRUBS

'GLOW GIRL' Birchleaf Spirea - Gold-leaf version of 'Tor.' Lemon-lime foliage holds the colour well and does not burn. Pink buds open to pure white blooms. Grows 3-4' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**



'GOLDMOUND' Spirea - Vibrant golden spring foliage, covered in clusters of pink flowers, shifts to a yellowish green in summer then a rich, yellowish orange in fall. Grows 2-3' tall x 4' wide. **Zone 4.**

'MAGIC CARPET' Spirea - Award winning dwarf shrub offers vibrant foliage and flower color. Bright gold foliage is accented with striking red leaf tips. Early spring flowers are deep pink-purple that cover the plant over a long period. Grows 18" tall x 2' wide. **Zone 3.**

SYMPHORICARPOS ALBUS



Snowberry - Tolerant of any soil type. Blue green foliage with white berries that persist into winter. Great for erosion control and to blend landscape with natural areas. Grows 5' tall & wide. **Zone 2.**

SYRINGA X BLOOMERANG



BLOOMERANG 'DARK PURPLE' Lilac - A re-blooming lilac that blooms in spring and again from mid-summer to frost. This cultivar has larger, more rounded inflorescences. It's very showy in spring, and continues to amaze with fragrant blooms. Requires good drainage. Disease resistant. Grows 4-6' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**



BLOOMERANG 'DWARF PINK' Lilac - This new & improved dwarf version of Bloomerang offers deeper pink flowers, greater vigor, and improved disease resistance. Blooms on old & new wood. Grows 2.5-3' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**



SYRINGA MEYERI



'PALIBIN' Dwarf Korean Lilac - A dense, compact lilac that gets covered in fragrant lilac-pink flowers. Blooms from late spring through until early summer. Tolerates light shade. Grows 4-5' tall x 5-7' wide. **Zone 3.**

SYRINGA PATULA



'MISS KIM' Korean Lilac - Small deciduous shrub. Green foliage with burgundy tint in fall. Flowers are strongly fragrant, icy mauve-pink. Slow grower. Full sun. Grows 3-5' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**

SYRINGA VULGARIS



'MADAME LEMOINE' French Lilac - Double white flowers with a strong fragrance. Blooms early. One of the best white lilacs. Attracts bees, butterflies and birds. Urban pollution tolerant. Grows 8-10' tall x 6' wide. **Zone 3.**

'MONGE' Lilac - Deep reddish-purple, 9" long flowers with a strong fragrance. Blooms in late spring for 3-4 weeks. Attracts bees, butterflies and birds. Urban pollution tolerant. Grows 10-12' tall x 10' wide. **Zone 3.**

'SENSATION' Lilac - Large trusses of purplish-red florets edged in white. Branches are erect and open with rich green foliage, turning burgundy to bronze in fall. Attracts bees, butterflies and birds. Moderate-growing to 10' tall x 6' wide. **Zone 3.**

CAREX



'ICE DANCE' Japanese Sedge - Rhizomatous & carpet forming but not invasive. Semi-evergreen ground cover with bright green glossy blades that have a cream-colored edge. Can handle full sun to full shade. Great for rain gardens. Grows 1' tall & spreads. **Zone 5.**

DESCHAMPSIA CESPITOSA



Tufted Hair Grass - Forms an arching shape. Great for slope stabilization & mass plantings. Clouds of tawny flowers emerge in early summer. Grows well in shade, however will not flower as abundantly. Urban pollution tolerant. Clump forming. Grows 2-3' tall x 1-2' wide. **Zone 4.**

'GOLDTAU' Gold Dew Tufted Hair Grass - Light and airy golden plumes cover the mounded foliage. Clump forming. Grows 2.5' tall X 2' wide. **Zone 4.**

'NORTHERN LIGHTS' Tufted Hair Grass - Variegated green and creamy white blades have a rosy pink color when emerging in early spring, & again as the weather cools. Semi-evergreen that prefers filtered sun. Grows 1' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

FESTUCA GLAUCA



'BEYOND BLUE' Blue Fescue - Valued for its clumping habit, semi-evergreen, & powdery blue foliage. Excellent for mass planting, edging, or in rock gardens. Clumps are easily divided in early spring, & should be divided every 3 years. Grows 10-12" tall x 18" wide. **Zone 4.**

HELICTOTRICHON SEMPERVIRENS



Blue Oat Grass - Dramatic powder blue foliage. Densely tufted, semi-evergreen, mounding form. Narrow, spiky, blue leaf blades. Best blue color in dry soils. Urban pollution tolerant. Rust resistant. Grows 3' tall x 2' wide. **Zone 4.**

COOL SEASON GRASSES

Grasses from cool climates come into growth in late winter and flower before mid-summer. Last year's growth should be cut down as soon as the snow is gone.

CALAMAGROSTIS



X ACUTIFLORA 'ELDORADO' Variegated Feather Reed Grass - Green leaves are variegated with bright yellow/gold midribs. Prefers full sun and well drained soil. Arching habit. Clump forming. Highly tolerant of urban pollution. Tan seed heads on showy plumes from late summer to late winter. Grows 4-5' tall x 2' wide. **Zone 4.**

X ACUTIFLORA 'KARL FOERSTER' Feather Reed Grass - Tall slender green foliage with bronze plumes from early summer through fall. Plant in full sun in groupings or use as a background. Urban pollution tolerant. Clump forming. Great for rain gardens. Grows 3-5' tall x 1.5-2.5' wide. **Zone 4.**



X ACUTIFLORA 'OVERDAM' Variegated Feather Reed Grass - White and green variegation and smaller in size, making it more refined than 'Karl Foerster.' Does well in hot sun with ample moisture, but likes a little shade in hot climates. Clump forming. Great for rain gardens. Grows 2.5-3' tall x 1.5-2' wide. **Zone 3.**

BRACYTRICHA Korean Feather Feed Grass - Feathery, pink-ish plumes appear on tall stems, rising above the foliage of this showy green ornamental grass, maturing in fall to light tan and cream. Partial shade to full sun. Air pollution tolerant. Grows 2-3' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

WEIGELA FLORIDA



'DATE NIGHT TUXEDO' Weigela - It has a compact form, with a striking contrast of white bell-shaped flowers against dark burgundy foliage. Best colour in full sun. Blooms in late spring, & again in summer in ideal conditions. Grows 4-5' tall x 3-4' wide. **Zone 4.**

'MIDNIGHT WINE' Weigela - Deep, rich wine-colored leaves and rosy-pink tubular flowers throughout spring. Blooms on old wood. Grows 18-24" tall x 2' wide. **Zone 3.**



'SONIC BLOOM PEARL' Weigela - The flowers open pure white with a yellow throat, then change to pink, giving you multiple colors on a single plant. Blooms in May and re-blooms until frost without deadheading. Blooms on old & new wood. Grows 4-5' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**



'SONIC BLOOM RED' Weigela - Lipstick red, trumpet-shaped flowers last from spring through frost without deadheading. Blooms on old & new wood. Grows 4-5' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**



'WINE AND ROSES' Weigela - Dark burgundy-purple leaves with hot pink-rose colored flowers. Quick grower. Blooms on old wood from spring throughout summer. Grows 4' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 4.**



YUCCA



YUCCA FILAMENTOSA Adam's Needle Yucca - Evergreen, blade-like leaves. Clump forming. In mid to late summer white flowers are borne in tall upright panicles. Salt tolerant. Grows 3-4' tall and wide (5' tall in bloom). **Zone 4.**

'COLOUR GUARD' Yucca - Sword-like, green leaves with a creamy gold center are topped by tall spikes of fragrant, ivory white blooms. Evergreen. Clumps form 3-4' tall x 4' wide, with flower spikes 4-6' tall. **Zone 4.**

YUCCA GLAUCA Soapweed Yucca - Pointed, evergreen, grey-blue leaves. Shorter stalk than filamentosas. White, bell shaped flowers in summer. Clusters to 2' tall. (3-4' tall in bloom) **Zone 3.**



THUJA OCCIDENTALIS

'SHERWOOD FROST' Cedar - A semi-dwarf cedar. Green foliage with creamy-white tips makes for a variegated look. Creamy white accents are most intense during early spring and fall. Grows 5-6' tall X 3-4' wide. **Zone 4.**

'SMARAGD' Emerald Cedar - The most common hedging cedar. Narrow pyramidal form with bright green foliage. Tolerant of alkaline soils. Requires moist soil. Grows 20'-25' tall X 5' spread. Suggest planted for hedging is 36" on centre. **Zone 4.**

Our Kelowna grown cedars come in either pots or B&B, depending on the size. We only dig the taller cedars in spring and fall. Please call or check online for our current size and availability.

THUJA PLICATA

'EXCELSA OKANAGAN' Western Red Cedar - Excelsa is the fastest growing of the Thujas, and is a tall conical tree. The bright green foliage turns bronze in winter. Excellent for a fast screen. Cuttings selected from an 'Excelsa' hedge in South East Kelowna that has proven cold hardy and vigorous over the past 20 years. Grows to a maximum height of 30' tall by 5-8' wide. **Zone 5.**

'WHIPCORD' Western Red Cedar - Drooping dwarf conifer with weeping, cord-like foliage has excellent specimen value. Also great for foundation plantings and rock gardens. Glossy green foliage usually acquires bronze tones in winter. Intolerant of dry conditions. Best in full sun, but generally appreciates some light afternoon shade in hot summer climates. Grows 4'-5' tall and wide. **Zone 5.**

TAXUS



'CUSPIDATA NANA' Dwarf Japanese Yew - A compact form with dark green needles. Takes to pruning and shearing well. Grows 3' tall X 6' wide. **Zone 4.**

X MEDIA 'H.M EDDIE' Eddie Yew- An attractive slower growing yew with good columnar form and dark green needles. Easy to prune. Grows 10' Tall X 4' wide. **Zone 4.**

X MEDIA 'HICKSII' Hick's Yew - An excellent evergreen shrub for tall hedges with dark green glossy, needle-like foliage and a narrow, columnar habit and bright red berries in fall. Pruning is best done in spring. Extremely low tolerance for wet feet, however can handle deep shade. Grows 12' tall X 5' spread. **Zone 4.**

X MEDIA 'HILLI' Hill's Yew - Upright oval to pyramidal in shape. Can be pruned at any time of year. Extremely low tolerance for wet feet, however it is one of the only evergreens that can handle full shade. Male selection means it does not produce berries. Grows 8' tall X 4' wide. **Zone 4.**

THUJA OCCIDENTALIS

'DANICA' Globe Cedar- Versatile, dwarf, globe shaped evergreen displaying bright emerald green foliage. Excellent choice for borders, foundation plantings, specimen or low hedges. Grows 2' tall and wide. **Zone 4.**

'DE GROOT'S SPIRE' Cedar - Narrow, strongly upright form of cedar. Scale-like evergreen foliage holds its color well throughout the winter. Fine small specimen or accent for landscapes of small size. Grows 8' tall X 2' wide. **Zone 3.**

'LITTLE GIANT' Globe Cedar - Slow growing, compact globe shaped evergreen. Soft feathery bright green foliage. Nice formal, tidy look. Great for a hedge, screen or smaller areas. Grows 4' tall and 4' wide. **Zone 3.**

ACER FREEMANII 'JEFFERSRED'

'AUTUMN BLAZE' Maple - Brilliant orange-red to red fall color. Upright branching with smooth gray bark. One of the best maple cultivars for quick growth and fall color. Grows 50' tall X 40'spread. **Zone 3.**

ACER GINNALA



AMUR Maple- A small tree or multi-stemmed shrub with a fine texture graceful spreading form. Fragrant yellow-white flowers in spring. Attractive glossy green lobed foliage in summer turns a vivid scarlet in fall. Grows 10-20' tall and wide. **Zone 2.**

ACER GRISEUM



PAPERBARK Maple- Soft green leaves turn scarlet in fall. Papery sheets of bark peel to reveal cinnamon-brown new bark. Excellent small landscape specimen. Grows 20' tall x 15-20' wide. **Zone 5.**

ACER PALMATUM DISSECTUM



'INABE SHIDARE' Japanese Maple - One of the most vigorous lace-leaf's. 'Inabe Shidare' has deep maroon spring and summer color with cascading growth. Fall color is crimson red. Large leaves for a dissectum, but finely divided. 4'- 10' tall with up to 10' spread. **Zone 5.**

'TAMUKEYAMA' Japanese Maple - Outstanding among the lace-leaf weepers for its rich foliage color. Leaves hold their deep purple color through the heat of summer better than other cultivars. Grows 8' tall by 12' wide. **Zone 5.**

'WATERFALL' Japanese Maple - Elegant, horizontal branching habit. Bright green summer foliage and fall color can range from apricot to fiery red. Excellent choice for night lighting. Grows 6'-8' tall by 8'- 10' wide. **Zone 5**

ACER PALMATUM



'BLOODGOOD' Japanese Maple - Widely used, well known, and reliable. Grown both as single trunked and multi-stem trees, Bloodgood is the standard for comparison among the purple leafed, upright growing Japanese maples. Grows 15' tall and wide. **Zone 5.**

'EMPEROR I' Japanese Maple - A definite improvement on Bloodgood, 'Emperor' has fuller branching and bright red foliage which resists summer fading. Moderate grower to 15' tall and wide. **Zone 5.**

'ELEGANS' Japanese maple - Serrated leaves emerge soft green and salmon pink in spring. Green foliage turns golden-yellow, orange and red in fall. Grows 5-10' tall X 6-8' wide. **Zone 5.**

'HARVEST ORANGE' / 'HARVEST RED' Japanese Maple - These upright, vase shaped Japanese Maples features soft green branches with lime green leaves in summer, followed by copper orange or hot red fall color. Grows 15' tall X 12' spread. **Zone 5.**

'SIERYU' Japanese maple - Delicate spring foliage emerges lime-green with reddish tips, maturing to pale green with reddish edges in summer. Spectacular golds, pale yellows, with hints of oranges and crimsons for fall. Best foliage comes from partial shade. Grows 10-15' tall by 8-12' wide. **Zone 5.**

'TROMBENBURG' Japanese Maple - 7-9 pointed, sharply serrated leaves emerge deep reddish-purple in spring. Foliage turns vibrant crimson-red in fall. One of the most sun tolerant Japanese maples. Grows 15-25' tall x 10-15' wide. **Zone 5.**

ACER PLATANOIDES



'CRIMSON KING' Norway Maple - Oval shaped when young, becoming round at maturity. Deep purple foliage with maroon to reddish bronze fall color. Grows 40' tall X 35' spread. **Zone 4.**

PINUS MUGO



'MUGHUS' Mugo Pine - Useful in masses, foundation planting or in groupings. Medium to dark green foliage. Very tolerant of alkaline soil. Grows 7' tall X 10' spread. **Zone 2.**

'PUMILIO' Dwarf Mugo Pine - Popular dwarf conifer displaying dark green needles on its shrubby habit of broadly spreading branches. Useful for rock gardens, mass plantings, and in groupings with broadleaf plants. A slow grower to 3'-5' tall X 6' wide. **Zone 2.**

'ROSTRATA' Swiss Mountain Pine - A symmetrical, upright mugo pine with a central leader. Dark green needles. Great for specimen planting. Grows 6-12" per year. Grows 12-15' tall X 6-8' wide. **Zone 3.**

PINUS NIGRA

'ARNOLD SENTINEL' Austrian Pine - A very narrow columnar evergreen conifer. Dark green, fine textured, stiff needles. Great for screening or as a specimen. Highly tolerant of urban pollution, including salt. Grows 25' tall X 7' wide. **Zone 4.**



'GREEN SELECT' Austrian Pine - Dense, smaller and more compact than the species. Deep green needles with contrasting white buds. Grows 20' tall X 10' wide. **Zone 4.**

PSEUDOTSUGA MENZIESII



DOUGLAS FIR - A fast growing dense evergreen with soft needles and a pyramidal-shaped tree. Dark green foliage. Grows to 66' tall X 33' wide. **Zone 4.**

PICEA PUNGENS



'ISELI FASTIGIATA' Spruce - A moderately fast-growing selection of Colorado Spruce with tight upward branching with bright blue needles. After 10 years of growth, a mature specimen will measure 12' tall x 3' wide. **Zone 2.**

'FAT ALBERT' Spruce - This Colorado spruce cultivar is noted for its dense, broad, upright pyramidal shape, closely-spaced, ascending branches and steel blue needle color. Grows slowly approximately (12"+ per year). Oblong cones (2-4" long) are greenish when young, maturing to light brown. Grows 10' - 15' tall and 7' - 8' wide. **Zone 3.**

'GLAUCA GLOBOSA' Globe Blue Spruce - A mounded blue spruce that can tolerate some shade. Tolerant of air pollution and salt. Grows 3-5' tall X 4-6' wide. **Zone 2.**

'GLAUCA GLOBOSA' TOP GRAFTED Tree Form Globe Spruce - A compact rounded evergreen with striking steel blue foliage, grafted onto a single stem to form a blue lollipop. A great patio tree or specimen. Grows 6' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 2.**

'MONTGOMERY' Blue Spruce - Mounding form when young, becoming conical with age. Maintains bright blue needles. Grows 4-6" per year. Grows 4-6' tall X 4' wide. **Zone 3.**

PINUS DENSIFLORA

'UMBRACULIFERA' Top Grafted Tanoyshe Pine - Slow growing, flat topped, umbrella-like evergreen on a standard, upright trunk. Dense, bright green needles. Grows 6' tall and wide. **Zone 4.**

PINUS FLEXILIS



'VANDERWOLF'S PYRAMID' Limber Pine - Pyramid shaped pine with long, twisted silvery blue-green needles displayed on dense branches. Resistant to insects and disease. Grows 20' tall X 10-15' wide. **Zone 4.**

ACER PLATANOIDES



'EMERALD QUEEN' Norway Maple - Upright oval shaped. New growth is brilliant reddish in spring, becoming dark green on maturity. Yellow fall color. Grows 50' tall by 40' spread. **Zone 4.**

ACER RUBRUM



'ARMSTRONG GOLD' Maple - An improved Armstrong with brighter foliage color, greater foliage density and compact, less leggy growth habit. Perfect for narrow street plantings. Grows 40' tall X 12' spread. **Zone 4.**

'BOWHALL' Maple - Tightly formed, narrow tree excellent for street planting. Dark green foliage with yellow-orange fall color. Grows 40' tall X 15' spread. **Zone 4.**

'BRANDYWINE' Maple - Green foliage shifts to a long-lasting show of color ranging from red, dark-red and brilliant purple. This seedless cultivar turns red 10 days later than most *Acer rubrum*. Grows 40' tall X 30' spread. **Zone 4.**

'REDPOINTE' Maple - Brilliant red fall color plus upright, broadly pyramidal form make this a standout. The refined form & foliage of the best *Acer rubrum* cultivars combined with the faster growth rate normally found in *Acer x freemanii*. Grows 45' tall X 30' spread. **Zone 5.**

'RED ROCKET' Maple - This red maple is one of the most cold hardy cultivars. Narrow, upright, & seedless. Fall color is very bright, orange-red to red. Grows 38' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 3.**

ACER TATARICUM

'RUGGED CHARM' Tataricum Maple - Compact and oval in form, the shapely canopy is a charming improvement over the hardy and rugged species! Bright red seed wings float in bright contrast against summer's green leaves. Fall color is a mix of yellow, orange and bright red. Grows 20' tall X 15' spread. **Zone 3.**



ACER TRUNCATUM X ACER PLATANOIDES

'CRIMSON SUNSET' Maple - Heat tolerance is the distinguishing characteristic of this hybrid. Its foliage resembles that of Crimson King, but its form is more upright and compact. It flourishes in the summer heat where few purple leafed plants will grow. Grows 35' tall X 25' wide. **Zone 4.**

AMELANCHIER



'AUTUMN BRILLIANCE' Serviceberry/ Saskatoon berry - Good form and strong branching. It displays reliable white cluster spring blooms and bright red fall color. Edible berries in June. Grows 20' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 4.**

BETULA PLATYPHYLLA



'DAKOTA PINNACLE' Fargo White Birch - Narrowly pyramidal, medium to fast growing birch. Dense, dark green foliage turns yellow in fall. Tolerant of drought, urban pollution, & Japanese beetle. Grows 40' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 3.**

'PARKLAND PILLAR' Japanese White Birch - dense, columnar form with pure white bark for winter interest. Dark green foliage turns an outstanding gold in fall. Great for screening, specimen or boulevard planting. Quick grower, & tolerant of urban pollution, bronze birch borer, & Japanese beetle. Grows 30' tall X 6' wide. **Zone 3.**

CARPINUS



'FASTIGIATA' - Pyramidal European Hornbeam - Narrow & upright in form, becoming broadly conical & open with age. Heat, drought, & air pollution resistant. Grows 35' tall X 25' wide. **Zone 5.**

'FRANS FONTAINE' Hornbeam - The narrowest of the horn-beam cultivars. Frans Fontaine Hornbeam is a dense deciduous tree with a narrowly upright and columnar growth habit. Dark green foliage with yellow fall color. Grows 35' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 5.**

JUNIPERUS SCOPULORUM



'MOONGLOW' Juniper - Beautiful medium sized upright evergreen with a broad pyramidal shape. Intense blue foliage all year long. Grows 20' tall X 8' wide. **Zone 3.**

'SKYROCKET' Juniper - Columnar growth habit with silver blue foliage. Fast grower to 15' tall X 2'-3' spread. **Zone 3.**

'WICHITA BLUE' Juniper - A broad, upright, pyramid growth habit with bright blue-gray foliage. Grows 12' tall X 5'

PICEA ABIES



'CUPRESSINA' Columnar Norway Spruce - Slender, uniform growth habit with dense branching to the ground. Dark green needles are slightly curved on closely set branches. Makes an ideal windbreak or privacy wall. Grows 20' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 2.**

'NIDIFORMIS' Bird's Nest Spruce - Classic evergreen with broad, flat branch structure. Spreading shrub with dark green needles. Slow grower at 1-6" per year. Grows 3' tall X 6' spread. **Zone 3.**

'PENDULA' Weeping Norway Spruce - weeping and irregularly shaped evergreen whose form will vary considerably depending upon its early training. Unless staked and supported, it generally does not grow upward, but instead will mostly spread along the ground. It can be a very unique specimen in the landscape. If staked and supported, it can grow generally upright into a 10-15' tall tree. If left grows 3' tall and 4' - 15' spread. **Zone 3.**

JUNIPERUS HORIZONTALIS



'BAR HARBOR' Juniper - Low growing blue-green foliage purplish in the winter. Adapts to soil conditions from dry alkaline to wetter conditions. Grows 1' tall X 10' spread. **Zone 3.**

'BLUE CHIP' Juniper - Evergreen groundcover with superb silver-blue foliage all year. One of the best blue ground cover junipers. Grows 8" tall X 6' spread. **Zone 3.**

'ICEE BLUE' Juniper - Low growing, spreading evergreen with intense silvery blue foliage forming a spectacular carpet of color. Excellent groundcover with tight mounding branches. Grows 4" tall X 7' spread. **Zone 3.**

'PRINCE OF WALES' Juniper - Low spreading evergreen with bright green foliage. Branches form starburst-like pattern displaying carpet of dense soft foliage. Fall color is purple-plum. Grows 8" tall X 10' spread. **Zone 3.**

'WILTONII' Juniper - One of the finest trailing junipers having a uniform, full centered growth habit with intense silver-blue evergreen foliage. Grows 6" tall X 6-8' wide. **Zone 3.**

JUNIPERUS SABINA



'CALGARY CARPET' Juniper - Soft green foliage on a low spreading juniper. Forms a thick mat. Very popular for banks, slope erosion, and mass plantings. Grows 1' tall X 10' spread. **Zone 3.**

JUNIPERUS SCOPULORUM



'BLUE ARROW' Juniper - An improved selection with tight, bright blue foliage and a very narrow, upright form. Perfect as a tall, narrow screen where space is limited. Makes a colorful evergreen addition to the garden. Grows 12'-15' tall X 2' wide. **Zone 4.**

CERCIDIPHYLLUM JAPONICUM

KATSURA - Pyramidal, later rounded and sometimes very wide spreading in shape. Bluish-green heart-shape leaves turn yellow, orange, and red in fall. Brown sugar fragrance in the fall. Grows 40' tall X 40' spread. **Zone 5.**

CORNUS FLORIDA



'CHEROKEE BRAVE' Dogwood - The most vigorous of the pink dogwoods; this cultivar shows resistance to both powdery mildew and spot anthracnose. It is impressive for its size, deeply colored foliage and bloom. Fall color is red. Grows 25' tall X 22' spread. **Zone 5.**

'RUBRA' - Pink Flowering Dogwood - Pink flowering in the spring with glossy red fruit attractive to birds and red fall color. Low branches extend horizontally which will lend a striking feature to the landscape. Grows 25' tall with equal spread. **Zone 5.**

CORNUS KOUSA



'SATOMI' Pink Chinese Dogwood - Same shape and size as 'Chinensis' with strong upright flower in a rich variety of muted pinks with maroon tinted leaves. Grows 20' tall X 20' wide. **Zone 5.**



'SUMMER GOLD' Dogwood - White bracted flowers held above bright green and golden yellow variegated foliage are flashy, eye catching combination in summer. In fall the golden margins turn pink, then the entire leaf turns bright red. Grows 15' tall and wide. **Zone 5.**



'VENUS' Dogwood - The biggest flower of any dogwood, very large 6 inch white flowers. Deep green foliage followed by red to purple-red fall color. Grows 25' tall X 20' wide. **Zone 5.**

TREES

CRATAEGUS LAEVIGATA



'PAUL'S SCARLET' Hawthorn - Scarlet to rose colored double flowers make this tree the showiest of all hawthorn in the spring. Has thorns. Grows 22' tall X 20' spread. **Zone 4.**

CRATAEGUS x MORDENENSIS



'SNOWBIRD' Hawthorn - One of the hardiest hawthorns. Highly recommended for small home land- scapes due to its upright oval shape. This tree resembles a cloud of double white flowers in spring, sparse red fruit in fall, with good disease resistance. This cultivar however, does have sharp thorns. Grows 20' tall X 12' wide. **Zone 3.**

'TOBA' Hawthorn - Double white, fragrant blossoms fade to rose. Use as a very showy specimen tree or focal point in the landscape. Has sharp thorns. Grows 16' tall X 12' spread. **Zone 3.**

FAGUS SYLVATICA



'DAWYCK GOLD' Gold Columnar Beech - Tall, narrow tree with pendulous branches. In the spring leaves emerge golden yellow, turning to a pale green in summer and reverting back to golden yellow in the fall. Grows 40' tall X 12' wide. **Zone 5**

'DAWYCK PURPLE' Purple Columnar Beech - Similar to the 'Dawyck Gold'. Tight and narrow in form, with purple leaf color that holds well in the summer. Grows 40' tall X 12' wide. **Zone 5.**

'RED OBELISK' Columnar Beech - similar to 'Dawyck Purple,' except 'Red Obelisk' has a more refined, compact habit. Deep purple, crinkled foliage with smooth, silver bark. Great tree for screening and narrow planting sites. Grows 35' tall X 12' wide. **Zone 5.**

CHAMAECYPARIS OBTUSA

'GRACILIS' Hinoki Cypress - Beautiful small evergreen with twisted dark green, irregular branches are held on tiered branches, creating an open habit. Great for small areas and Japanese gardens. Grows to 15' tall X 6' wide **Zone 4.**

CHAMAECYPARIS PISIFERA



'GOLDEN MOPS' Gold Thread False Cypress - A ground-hugging mop-like mound. Yellow foliage makes for great contrast. Great for rock gardens, berm plantings, or as an accent. Grows 3-5' tall & wide. **Zone 4.**

'SOFT SERVE' False Cypress - A compact, conical false cypress with graceful, soft fern-like branches. The leaves are bright green on top and flecked with silver-blue on the underside. A great substitute in the Okanagan for Dwarf Alberta Spruce. Grows 6'-10' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 5.**



JUNIPERUS CHINENSIS



'GOLD COAST' Juniper - Compact spreading form with golden yellow new growth. Color deepens in the cold weather. Graceful appearance. Grows 3' tall X 6' spread. **Zone 4.**

'MINT JULEP' Juniper - Arching, fountain like form with mint green foliage. Will tolerate windy, dry, full sun exposure. Grows 6' tall X 8' spread. **Zone 4.**

'SPARTAN' Juniper - Handsome, fast growing specimen forms dark green, densely branched columns useful as a screen or windbreak. Excellent sheared topiary. Tolerates heat, cold and drought. Grows 15' tall X 3-5' wide. **Zone 5.**

EVERGREENS

ABIES CONCOLOR

'CANDICANS' White Fir - 'Candicans' has attractive silvery blue foliage. The needles are highly ornamental and remain silvery blue throughout. Grows 30' tall X 10' wide. **Zone 4.**

CHAMAECYPARIS LAWSONIANA

COLUMNARIS GLAUCA' Lawson Blue Cypress - Upright symmetrical evergreen of beautiful rich, steel blue color. Columnar shape. Will grow in any location, preferably well drained. Can be used for hedging. A moderate grower to 9' tall X 3' spread. **Zone 5.**

'OKANAGAN GOLD' Lawson Gold Cypress - Upright symmetrical evergreen with golden tips. Columnar shape. Will grow in any location, preferably well drained soil. Can be used for hedging. Very heat and cold tolerant. Cuttings selected from hedge along Reid Road in South East Kelowna. Grows up to 25' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 4.**

'STARDUST' Lawson Gold Cypress - Vigorous, conical selection. Has feathery foliage, with rich yellow to bronze-tipped foliage. Medium growth rate. Grows 15' tall X 6' wide. **Zone 5.**

CHAMAECYPARIS NOOTKATENSIS

'PENDULA' - Weeping Alaskan Cedar/ Nootka Cypress - Soft, pendulous green foliage, conical crown with numerous drooping branches to the ground. This makes a beautiful specimen tree that can be effectively used as a graceful screen. Grows 30' X 10' wide **Zone 5.**

FRAXINUS AMERICANA



'AUTUMN PURPLE' White Ash - This ash has beautiful fall colors of various hues in different years vary from mottled yellow orange to orange red and deep purple. Seedless. Grows 45' tall X 40' spread. **Zone 4.**

FRAXINUS PENNSYLVANICA



'RUGBY' Prairie Spire Green Ash - Dense, upright, and narrowly pyramidal in mature form, this selection comes from a very hardy northern plains seed source. Dark green glossy foliage turns yellow in fall. This fast growing tree makes a great specimen, boulevard planting, or park plantings. Grows 45' tall X 20' wide. **Zone 3.**

GINCKGO BILOBA



Ginkgo Maidenhair Tree - unique fan-shaped leaves turn from green into a golden-yellow in fall. Disease resistant, tolerant of compacted soil, and urban pollution, including road salt. Great as a specimen or for boulevard planting. Slow grower to 50' all X 30' spread. **Zone 4.**

GLEDITSIA TRIACANTHOS



'SKYLINE' Honey Locust - The most widely used honey locust cultivar, broadly pyramidal shaped. Fine textured medium green foliage turns yellow to golden in the fall. An ideal street tree in many situations. Seedless. Grows 45' tall X 35' wide. **Zone 4.**

'SUNBURST' Honey Locust - Used for its bright golden yellow, fine textured foliage. The new growth is always bright yellow which contrasts with the darker yellow/green interior foliage. Grows 40' tall X 35' spread. **Zone 4.**

GLEDITSIA TRIACANTHOS



'STREET KEEPER' Honey Locust - An ideal tree for city streets, this cultivar boasts the tight, narrow form that has long been lacking in urban tolerant honey locust. The ascending branch structure gives Street Keeper a canopy that is only half as wide as other cultivars. Foliage is deeper green than other selections. Grows 45' tall X 20' wide. **Zone 4.**

HIBISCUS— TOP GRAFTED



'BALI' HIBISCUS Tree Form - The tree form of 'Bali' hibiscus is perfect for small landscapes or as a specimen plant. It blooms from July - September with double pure white flowers, which are highlighted with a bold purple red center. Grows 6' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 5.**

HYDRANGEA-TOP GRAFTED



'LIMELIGHT' Hydrangea Tree Form - The unique shrub grafted onto a standard to raise the flowers to eye level. Soft lime green flowers emerge in summer, turn white, then finally pink to deep magenta in fall. Best pruned in late winter after the risk of extreme cold has passed. Grows 7' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 3.**

'VANILLA STRAWBERRY' Hydrangea Tree Form - The enormous flower panicles are a blend of vanilla and strawberry, held upright on red stems. They emerge creamy white in mid-summer, change to pink and finally to strawberry red. Salt tolerant. Best pruned in late winter or early spring. Grows 7' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 4.**

'PHANTOM' Hydrangea Tree Form - Dense conical flowers open creamy white, flush to lime green in summer, & turn soft to deep pink in fall. Improved stems do not flop from 15" flowers. Salt tolerant. Grows 7' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 4.**

SYRINGA BLOOMERANG-TOP GRAFTED



'BLOOMERANG DARK PURPLE' Lilac - A sturdy standard raises the fragrant purple blooms to eye level. Springtime display of dark purple flowers is repeated until late summer, adding months of color. Grows 8' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 3.**

'BLOOMERANG PINK PERFUME' Lilac - Pink reblooming lilac, has the same multi-season flower show, only this time in pink. Grafted to eye level. Grows 8' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 3.**



SYRINGA RETICULATA



'IVORY SILK' Japanese Tree Lilac - Produces fragrant, creamy white flowers in early and mid summer. Useful as a small specimen tree. Steel-gray bark provides winter interest. Best flower production comes from full sun. Grows 20' tall X 16' spread. **Zone 4.**

'CHINA SNOW' Pekin Lilac - Large sprays of cream-white flowers are borne in June by this small ornamental tree. Amber to orange-brown exfoliating bark extends seasonal interest through the winter months. Best flower production comes from full sun. Grows 20' tall and wide. **Zone 5.**

TILIA CORDATA



'CORINTHIAN' Linden - The most narrow of the Lindens. Small deep green leaves provide fine texture and a delicate appearance. Adaptable to many types of soils, as well as urban pollution, making it a great street tree. Grows 45' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 3.**

'GREENSPIRE' Linden - Does well under difficult conditions. A very handsome tree with an narrow oval mature form. Well branched with a strong central leader. Grows 40' tall X 30' spread. **Zone 4.**

QUERCUS ROBUR X



X BICOLOR 'NADLER'/ 'KINDRED SPRIT' Oak - Among the tightest of columnar trees, its growth habit, mildew and drought resistance, and tolerance of urban soils make this the ideal street tree for narrow streets. Grows 30' tall X 6' wide. **Zone 4.**

QUERCUS RUBRA



Red Oak - Fast growing for an oak, up to two feet per year. Dark green foliage becomes red-brown to red in the fall. Grows 50' tall X 45' spread. **Zone 4.**

ROBINIA PSEUDOACACIA



'TWISTY BABY' Locust - Unique dwarf tree with interesting twisted branches. The contorted form makes an excellent small patio specimen and conversation piece. This tree is drought and pest resistant but will respond favorably to rich, well-drained, moist soil. Prune back annually to encourage contorted growth. Grows 15' tall X 18' wide. **Zone 4.**

SALIX ALBA



'TRISTIS' Weeping Golden Willow - Golden stems and graceful habit. Fast growing, tough and adaptable. This willow will grow in wet areas where nothing else will. Light green foliage with yellow fall color. Likes full sun. Grows 40' tall X 60' spread. **Zone 3.**

SORBUS ACUPARIA

'CARDINAL ROYAL' Mountain Ash - A vigorous tree with upright branches and a very symmetrical, tidy habit. This tree was selected for its clusters of small brilliant red berries, much more spectacular than the orange of the species. Dark green foliage is silvery beneath. Grows 35' tall X 20' wide. **Zone 2.**

LIQUIDAMBAR STYRACIFLUA



'WORPELSDON' Sweetgum - A large, stately tree with a pyramidal form and upright branching makes it a great shade tree used in park and large properties. Green foliage turns brilliant yellows, oranges, purples, and reds in fall. Fast grower to 40' tall X 25' wide. **Zone 5.**

LIRIODENDRON TULIPIFERA



'FASTIGIATA' Columnar Tulip Tree - Tall, narrow and tightly fastigiated. Foliage is bright green in summer and can be very showy in fall with a range of golden-yellows. Tulip-shaped, yellow green blooms, with orange band at base. Blooms from late May through mid-June. Cone-like aggregate fruits that persist in winter. Full to part sun. Fast grower to 50' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 5.**

MAGNOLIA

'GALAXY' Magnolia - A tree form, deciduous magnolia with a strong central leader. Reddish purple, slightly fragrant flowers in mid-spring, up to 8" across. Plant in a protected area to prevent frost damage on early blooming flowers. Grows 30' tall X 15' wide. **Zone 5.**

'ROYAL STAR' Magnolia - Multi-stem with white flowers. Flowers are larger & showier than the species, with nearly twice as many petals. Often considered the best stellata cultivar. Plant in a protected area to prevent frost damage on early blooming flowers. Grows 15' tall X 10' wide. **Zone 5.**



'SUSAN' Magnolia - A multi-stem tree with fragrant reddish-purple flowers, up to 5" across. Blooms about 2 weeks after Magnolia stellata, so this escapes potential frost damage of flowers. Grows 8-12' tall & wide. **Zone 3.**



PLATANUS x ACERIFOLIA

'BLOODGOOD' London Plane - Large maple-like leaf with medium to dark green color. Yellow fall color. Fast growing, used for boulevard or feature tree plantings. Adaptable to soil compaction & moisture conditions as well as restricted root space; tolerant to urban conditions, including air pollution. Very popular in the Okanagan. Naturally shedding bark creates a dappled brown & cream pattern. Grows 50' tall X 40' spread. **Zone 4.**

POPULUS TREMULA

'ERECTA' Swedish Columnar Aspen - An excellent narrow growing tree which can be used as a substitute for the Lombardy Poplar. Green foliage trembles in breeze, and turns yellow in fall. Seedless. Grows 40' tall X 10' spread. **Zone 2.**

POPULUS TREMULOIDES



'TREMBLING Aspen - Pyramidal shaped tree. Light green foliage trembles in the breeze. Yellow fall color. Silvery-grey bark. Naturalizes well. Grows 30'tall X 15' spread. **Zone 2.**

PRUNUS



'CRIMSON POINTE' Flowering plum - The narrow columnar shape makes it the perfect specimen for smaller landscapes. Pink buds open to white flowers in early spring, and are followed by showy, glossy purple-red to purple-bronze foliage. Produces small ornamental fruit in summer. Can take full shade or full sun. Quick grower to 20' tall X 5-6' wide. **Zone 4.**

ATROPURPUREA 'PISSARDI' Plum - Reddish purple to greenish-bronze summer foliage. In spring, pale pink flowers fade to white. Flowers are followed by ornamental plums in autumn. Striking accent or feature tree. Grows 25' tall X 25' spread. **Zone 5.**



PYRUS CALLERYANA



'CHANTICLEER' Pear - A densely growing, narrow selection suitable for street plantings. It is resistant to fire blight and much less susceptible to wind breakage than Bradford. Green glossy foliage turns red in fall. White flowers in clusters. Grows 40' tall X15' wide. **Zone 4.**

QUERCUS COCCINEA



SCARLET Oak - Upright spreading, open and broadly oval shape tree. Autumn brings deep, brilliant shades of red considered one of the best fall colours for oaks. Grows 50' tall X 40' spread. **Zone 4.**

QUERCUS PALUSTRIS



PIN Oak - Dark glossy green foliage turning red to bronze in the fall. Pyramidal in shape. One of the fastest growing oaks. Grows 55' tall X 35' spread. **Zone 4.**

'PRINGREEN' / 'GREEN PILLAR' oak - Fastigate branching habit and a very dense, columnar shape make this tree ideal for narrow street plantings. Deep red in the fall. Grows 50' tall X 15' spread. **Zone 4.**

QUERCUS ROBUR X

X ALBA 'CRIMSCHMIDT' CRIMSON SPIRE Oak - This columnar, tightly fastigate hybrid of English and White Oak produces dark-green to bluish green mildew-resistant foliage with rusty red fall color. Holds its leaves in most conditions through the winter. Grows 45' tall X 15' spread. **Zone 4.**

X BICOLOR 'LONG' / 'REGAL PRINCE' Oak- Mildew-resistant. Summer foliage is glossy, clean and bright green. This adaptable hybrid of English and Swamp White Oak is notable for excellent columnar form. Grows 45' tall X 18' wide. **Zone 4.**
