TERMS

Net 30 days to those with established accounts, otherwise cash, debit card or credit card (all credit card transactions will have a 2.4% surcharge). Interest is charged at the rate of 5% per month o overdue accounts. Overdue accounts will automatically turn over to COD until brought back to current standing. Customers not making annual purchases will be requested to re-apply for an account. Accounts that do less than \$1000 business in one season will be turned over to COD terms. All accounts must be paid by the end of the season or will be subject to a 5% per moth late payment charge.

GUARANTEE

All stock is guaranteed true to name. Seller gives no other warranty, expressed or implied. Condition, growth and production after pick up or delivery is the responsibility of the buyer. No returns.

HOLDING POLICY

Confirmed orders placed with Foxglove Wholesale Nursery will be held at no charge for a maximum of 30 days. After 30 days, a 10% non refundable deposit will be charged to continue holding material, otherwise plants will be returned to stock. Additional maintenance holding fees may be charged depending on length of time plants are to be held.

SHIPPING

All goods travel at purchaser's risk and expense. After goods are delivered to forwarders, our responsibility ceases. Customers who give us no shipping instructions agree to let us use the carrier of our choice, without responsibility on or part. Freight charges will be invoiced by Foxglove Wholesale Nursery at the time of shipment and are due on receipts. A Foxglove Wholesale Nursery delivery truck is available at an hourly rate for delivery. COD account holders must pay for orders prior to shipping.

PICK UP ORDERS

Customers picking p their orders are required to give us at least 48 hours notice prior to pick up. Please ensure you arrive with tarps or other suitable coverings to protect your plants on your truck as even a short trip without proper care can kill nursery stock.

CHECK FOR DROUGHT TOLERANT PLANTS:



ACER GINNALA

AMUR MAPLE - A graceful shrub or small tree with slender branches. Delicate leaves are medium green with brilliant orange to bright red autumn color. 15 ft high with eaual spread. Zone 3.



AMELANCHIER ALNIFOLIA

SASKATOON/ **SERVICEBERRY - Works** well in a natural setting, fruit is edible, tolerates harsh climates and alkaline soil. Single white blossoms in spring. 10 -15 ft high with equal spread. Zone 2.







ARCTOSTAPHYLOS UVA URSI

KINNIKINICK - Outstanding evergreen groundcover that does best in sandy infertile soils. Very salt tolerant. Has small pink flowers followed by bright red fruit.

Grows to 6 inches high, spreads well. **Zone 2**.





ARONIA MELANOCARPA

BLACK Chokecherry -

Red and purple fall foliage. White spring flowers. Black fruit attracts birds. An adaptable, deer resistant plant. Grows 5' - 7' and 4' - 5' wide.

Zone 3.



BERBERIS THUNBERGII

AUREA NANA - Golden Dwarf Barberry - Is a dense, compact shrub that originates from eastern Asia and Japan. Its small, attractive, goldengreen leaves turn orangeyellow in the fall. Bright red berries which are attractive to birds, appear in late summer to fall and persist into winter. Grows 2 - 3' tall and wide.

Zone 4



CHERRY BOMB Barberry -

Compact shrub with striking burgundy-red leaves and brilliant scarlet fall color; this spiny shrub can be used in a hedge as a deterrant to tresspassers; best color in full sun. Grows 4' high and 4' wide. **Zone 4**.

CONCORD Barberry – A tidy ball with velvety, deep purple foliage. Grows 18 inches tall and wide. **Zone 4**.

ROSE GLOW Barberry - Spectacular shrub with mottled red, green, white & pink leaves. Has bright red berries in fall which persist through winter. Does best in full sun. Grows 5-6 ft high with similar spread.

Zone 3.

ROYAL BURGUNDY Barber-

ry - Velvet-like rich burgundy color foliage, darkens to even richer hues in fall. Bright red berries. Tidy compact form with spreading habit is versatile for filling out planting areas in group or masses. Full sun. Moderate grower to just 2ft tall, spreading to 3ft wide. **Zone 4.**



RUBY CAROUSEL Barberry - A low rounded, red leafed barberry with excellent uniformity. A great choice for low hedges or foundation plantings. Full sun. Grows 3ft tall and wide. **Zone 4.**



BUDDLEIA DAVIDII

BLACK KNIGHT Butterfly Bush - This is the darkest flowering variety, almost a grape violet, and sweetly fragrant, blooming from early summer through fall. Grows best in full sun. Fast growing to 6 ft tall. Zone 5.

BUDDLEIA HYBRID

LO & BEHOLD 'Blue Chip Jr' – The next generation of 'Blue Chip' - young junior is smaller, less brittle and has attractive silver-green leaves. 20-28 inches tall and wide. **Zone 5**

MISS MOLLY— Sangria-red summer flowers attract butter-flies and hummingbirds. Compact. Fragrant and deer resistant. Grows 4-5' Tall and wide. **Zone 5**.



BUXUS

WINTER GEM BOXWOOD -

Glossy leaved, densely branched shrub with bright green new spring growth. Excellent hedging plant. 3-4 ft high with 4 ft spread. **Zone 5.**

GREEN GEM Boxwood -

'Green Gem' is a hybrid boxwood cultivar, that is noted for its globular shape and excellent winter hardiness. Grows 18-24 inch tall and wide. **Zone 4.**



Superb low growing boxwood. Needs little pruning. Compact form with small leaves. Ideal for hedges & borders. 3 ft high x 3 ft wide. **Zone 4**.

Zone 4. CARYOPTERIS



BLUE MIST BLUEBEARD- Attractive compact, mounding grower with fragrant powder blue blooms. Long blooming season

Grows 2.5-3' tall and wide. **Zone 5.**

SUNSHINE BLUE II BLUEBEARD- Bright yellow foliage; blue flow-PROVEN ers in late spring through autumn; improved hardiness.



CORNUS SERICEA

IVORY HALO - Variegated **Dogwood** - The same light areen and white foliage and brilliant red winter stems of the reaular form, but only twothirds the size. Grows 5' tall and wide.

Zone 3.



ARCTIC FIRE - Red Twig Dogwood - Proven Winner. Green leaf with rich red stems in fall PROVEN through winter and early spring. Compact and nonsuckering. Grows 2 - 4 ft with equal spread.

Zone 3.



ARCTIC FIRE - Yellow Twig Dogwood - Proven Winner. Green leaf with rich yellow stems in fall through winter and early spring. Compact and non-suckering. Grows 4-6 ft with equal spread. Zone 2.

RED OSIER Dogwood - Bright red stems, eye-catchina in a winter setting. Excellent for mass plantings. 8 ft high with 5 - 10 ft spread. **Zone 3.**





COTINUS COGGYGRIA

Winecraft Black Smoke **Bush-** round leaves emerge rich purple but as summer's heat comes on. they turn a deep nearblack tone and finally light up in an array of reds and oranges in fall.. 4-6 ft high with equal spread.





Winecraft Gold Smoke Bush -

Waxy leaves emerge a sunny orange, soon take on a golden hue, then mature to a cheerful chartreuse for the season. Grows 4'-6' tall and wide.

Zone 5.



COTONEASTER



DAMMERI Cotoneaster Roots readily where branches touch the ground. One of the best ground covers. Excellent on slopes and gentle banks. Less than 1 ft high with 4 ft spread. Zone 5.

DAMMERI 'CORAL BEAUTY' Evergreen, fast growing
ground cover with oval,
glossy, bright green leaves
and bright red fruit. This
plant prefers well drained
acidic soil that is slightly

rocky. Grows 1 - 2' tall X 6' wide. **Zone 5**.



HORIZONTALIS - Rock Spray Cotoneaster - Glossy green foliage turning reddish purple in the fall. Works well as a groundcover or bank stabilizer. Grows 3 ft high with 5 - 8 ft spread. **Zone 5.**



LUCIDUS - Hedging Cotoneaster - Lustrous dark green leaves with yellow red combinations in the fall. Excellent for hedges, screening or in group plantings for color. 9 ft high with 7 ft spread. **Zone 2**.



EUONYMUS

BURNING BUSH- Compacta—

prized for its intense scarlet red fall coloring. The interesting, compact, mounded form displays attractive rich green leaves spring through summer. Grows 6'-8'- tall, 8'-10' Wide. **Zone 4.**



EUONYMUS ALATUS

BURNING BUSH-Winged -

Excellent in hedges, groups or as a specimen plant. Winged bark adds to the winter landscape. Fall color is exceptional red. Grows 10 ft high with 6-

10 ft spread.

Zone 3.



BURNING BUSH - 'Fireball' - Proven Winner. Compact burning bush with tighter branching and superior stem hardiness. Grows 5 - 7 ft and 3 - 4 ft wide. Zone 3.

EUONYMUS FORTUNEI



EMERALD AND GOLD Euonymous - Semi-evergreen with deep green foliage margined with yellow. A low growing shrub with a tight branching habit. Grows 2 ft high with 4 ft spread. **Zone 5**.

EMERALD GAIETY Euonymous - Semi-evergreen with deep green foliage margined with white. A low growing shrub with a tight branching habit. Grows 4 ft high x 4 ft spread. Will also climb walls and structures. Zone 5.



EUONYMUS

TURKESTAN BURNING Bush - An attractive semi-evergreen dwarf plant with narrow leaves with slightly weeping branches. Flowers pink seed capsules in spring. Fall color is pinkish-red. Grows 3' tall X 3' wide. **Zone 3**.



FORSYTHIA



OVATA 'NORTHERN GOLD' - Earliest blooming forsythia. Very hardy. Useful as a shrub and in massing and groupings. Grows 7 ft high with 7 ft spread. **Zone 4.**

X INTERMEDIA 'SHOW OFF STAR-

LET' - This dwarf forsythia is a mass of bright yellow spring flowers from base to tip. Improved flower display compared to older varieties. Grows 2'- 3' tall and wide. **Zone 4.**



HIBISCUS SYRIACUS

HIBISCUS SYRIACUS - Rose of Sharon - This hardy strong growing plant not only attracts Hummingbirds and Butterflies but is also Deer resistant. Blooming mid to late summer. Grow 8 - 12 ft high and 5 ft wide. Check our on line availability for on hand varieties. Blue Satin is shown here. **Zone 5.**



HIBISCUS SYRIACUS



LIL KIM' - Say hello to the first dwarf Rose of Sharon! Lil Kim is with dainty little white flowers punctuated with a showy red eye. Dwarf. Deer resistant.

Grows 3-4' tall and wide. Zone 5.

'LIL KIM RED' - This newest addition to the Lil' Kim series has a compact habit and rich, deep rosy-red flowers.

Grows 3-4' tall and wide. Zone 5.

'LIL KIM VIOLET' - It has the same compact habit but with plum-violet flowers accented by a red eye. Zone 5.



HYDRANGEA ARBORESCENS

ANNABELLE Hydrangea -Low growing rounded shrub. Has large white flower clusters in summer. Will tolerate sun. Grows 5 ft high with 3 ft spread.

Zone 3.







INCREDIBALL Hydrangea - This plant produces huge flowers (as much as 12" across) is reliable and beautiful. Very cold hardy. Blooms on new arowth so even very cold winters won't keep it from blooming. Massive flowers bloom in summer, and are held up by very sturdy stems. Prune back in late winter/early spring. Very hardy and reliable. Good for cut flowers. Grows 4-5' high. Zone 3.

INVINCIBELLE RUBY-

Dark, near –red flower buds open to a two toned combination of bright ruby red and silvery pink. Dark green foliage and strong stems ensure outstanding performance. Strong rebloomer. Grows 3-4' tall and wide. **Zone 3**.



PW PROVEN WINNERS

INVINCIBELLE WEE WHITE- IT

reaches just 1-2.5' tall and is covered in pure white mophead flowers from summer to fall. The blooms start white and age to shades of green and pink - and they keep coming, with fresh buds being produced through autumn. Strong stems prevent flopping. Prune in early spring, reducing height by about a third. Grows 1-2.5' tall and 2-3' wide. **Zone 3**.

HYDRANGEA MACROPHYLLA



WEE BIT GIDDY— Red-Pink Mophead blooms, tight compact growth, glossy disease resistant foliage and strong stems. Re-blooming, red-pink flowers can also be turned dark violet-purple when treated with aluminum sulfate. Grows 2' tall x 2.5' wide. Zone 5.



HYDRANGEA MACROPHYLLA

NIKKO BLUE Hydrangea -

Superb shrub. Handsome foliage on boldly branched mounded form. Abundant showy blue globe-shaped flowers in late summer. Grows 4 - 6 ft high and wide.

Zone 5.



PINK BEAUTY Hydrangea -Hardy and drought tolerant with 4" round pink blooms deepening toward crimson with age. Stems and young leaves are purplish in color. Grows 4' high & wide. Zone 5.

HYDRANGEA PANICULATA





BOBO Hydrangea-

Loads of flowers on a tiny plant! Bobo is a delightful plant that is enaulfed by large white flowers in summer. In fall they can turn pinkish. Grows 30-36 inches tall and 36-48 inches wide. Zone 3.

HYDRANGEA PANICULATA





FIRELIGHT Hydrangea-Upright panicles are packed with flowers which transform from pure white to rich pomegranate-pink. Its thick, sturdy stems hold up the beautiful flowers so they are prominently displayed in the garden. Grows 6'-8' tall and wide. **Zone 3.**

LIMELIGHT Hydrangea -

An exciting new hardy hydrangea. Limelight has unique bright green blooms in mid-summer that holds its bright and refreshing color right into fall, when the blooms change color to a rich deep pink. Full sun to light shade. Grows to 6 to 8ft high and wide. Zone 3. ALSO AVAILBLE IN LITTLE LIME GROWING 3 - 5' tall and wide.





HYDRANGEA SERRATA



TUFF STUFF AH-HA

Dinner plate-sized blooms encircled with a ring of waterlily-like double florets in blue or pink. Exceptional rebloomer. Great for containers. Grows 2'-3' Tall and wide. Zone 5.

ITEA VIRGINICA 'LITTLE HENRY'



This compact Sweetspire starts out the summer with a beautiful display of fragrant white flowers that blanket the shrub. As PROVEN summer progresses shiny, disease-free foliage appears until



fall when the foliage turns a stunning garnetred. Grows 2-3' tall and wide. Zone 5.

KERRIA JAPONICA 'PLENIFLORA'

Double Flowering Japanese Kerria - Large shrub with archina branches. Grows to 6 ft tall x 4 ft wide. Perfect choice for shady spot. Double yellow pom-pom flowers in spring, stems stay green in winter. Zone 5.



LIGUSTRUM VULGARE 'CHEYENNE'

Cheyenne Privet - Dark green, lance shaped leaves. Fragrant white flowers followed by round blue-black fruit. This shrub is a perfect choice for borders and hedging. Grows up to 10 ft high and wide.



MAGNOLIA STELLATA

ROYAL STAR Magnolia -Upright, densely branched shrub with large fragrant white starshaped double flowers appearing before foliage in spring. Moderate grower to 10 - 15 ft tall, 10 - 12 ft wide. Zone 5.



MAHONIA AQUIFOLIUM

Oregon Grape - Glossy ever-green foliage, reddish bronze when unfolding, purplish bronze in the fall. Bright yellow flowers form into blue black berries. Grows 3 - 6 ft high with equal spread.

Zone 4.



PHILADELPHUS LEWISII

Native Mock Orange - Spreading shrub with arching branches.
Branches of fragrant, single, cup shaped white flowers are produced in early or midsummer. Grows 10 ft high with equal spread.

Zone 3.

PHILADELPHUS X VIRGINALIS

MINNESTOTA SNOWFLAKE Mock Orange - Perfect white fragrant flowers, not particular about soil, needs full to partial sun. Grows 6 - 8 ft high with a 5 - 6 ft spread. Zone 2.





PHYSOCARPUS OPULIFOLIUS



'Dart's Gold' - is a compact deciduous shrub with bright yellow leaves when young, turning greener, and clusters of small, cream or pink-tinged flowers in early summer. Grows 4' - 5' high and 3' wide. Zone 3.

LUTEUS - Golden Ninebark - Bright yellow foliage becomes yellow green in summer, peeling bark adds winter interest. Useful as a screen or in a hedge. Grows 8 ft high with 8 ft spread. **Zone 2**.



MONLO - Diablo Ninebark -Long arching branches display reddish-purple foliage. A rounded shrub that should be planted in full sun to achieve best foliage color. Attractive pink flowers in early summer followed by a red seed. Grows 8-10 ft high with eaual spread. Zone 4.

COPPERTINA - Ninebark -Loose and informal habit. Can be pruned heavily to form dense shrub or open small tree-like form. Pinkwhite flowers in summer and glorious rich red fall foliage. Best foliage color in full sun. Grows 8-10' high and 4-6'

wide. Zone 3.



TINY WINE GOLD- A new gold version of tiny wine with the same bushy habit and small refined leaves. This is a heavy blooming plant. Good mildew resistance. Grows 3-4' tall and wide. Good in containers or small spaces. Zone 3.



TINY WINE- A new dwarf ninebark that is smaller than others in the market, Tiny Wine is extra bushy, with small, refined leaves. The dark maroon foliage is colorful all season, and contrasts beautifully with the white flowers in late spring. Good in containers. Grows 3'-4' tall and wide.





POTENTILLA FRUTICOSA



ABBOTSWOOD Potentilla One of the best white potentillas, dark foliage, spreading habit, needs full sun for best flowering. Grows 3 ft x 3 ft. Zone 2.

RHODODENDRON

HELLIKKI Rhododendronbroadleaf evergreen shrub featuring large showy dark violet-red flowers appear on even young plants.; absolutely must have well-drained, highly acidic soil. Grows 5' tall and wide. Zone 4.





PURPLE PASSION Rhodo-dendron - Beautiful large purple blooms with dark red spots. Purple passion is upright and vase-shaped, with deep green leaves. Grows 5' tall and wide. **Zone 4.**

RHODODENDRON

RAMAPO Rhododendron- Dense-growing evergreen shrub has very dwarf compact habit. showy clusters of bright lavender-purple flowers from early to mid-spring. Grows 3' tall X 4' wide. **Zone 4**.



RHODODENDRON PJM

ELITE - A hardy evergreen shrub bearing bright pinkish-lavender flowers in the spring. The dark green foliage turns plum color in the fall. The most vigorous and upright-growing of the PJM clones. Very cold and heat tolerant. Grows 5-6' with equal width. **Zone 4.**



RHUS AROMATIC

Gro-Low - Fragrant SumacThis vigorous shrub hugs the ground with a spreading habit making an excellent choice for stabilizing a bank or smothering weeds. It has yellow flowers, red fruit and glossy leaves that change to an impressive orange-red fall color. Grows 1' - 3' high and spreads up to 10'. Zone 3

RHUS TYPHINA

TYPHINA -Staghorn Sumac - Bright green summer foliage with orange to red fall color, suckers freely from roots making it a stabilizing plant. 10-13 ft high with equal spread. Zone 3.



RHUS TYPHINA



TIGER EYES Sumac - Beautiful golden-leafed form of Cutleaf Staghorn Sumac. New growth is a lively chartreuse green, quickly changing to yellow, both colors contrasting nicely with rosy-pink leaf stems. Fast growing to 6'. Zone 3.

RIBES ALPINUM



Alpine Currant - Deep bright green leaf, good for hedging or mass planting, Tolerates all soils. Prefers full sun. Grows 4-6 ft high with equal spread. Zone 2.

LANDSCAPE ROSES

These roses are selected from a variety of classes, based on their ease of care. They are disease-resistant, require little pruning, grow quickly to fill a space, and provide a long seasonal show of color.

Rosa 'Meidiland' - Showy, reblooming, carefree shrub roses, very disease resistant,

very reliable roses offering a good variety of colors and sizes. Meidilands are ideal for hedges, borders and bank plantings. * Available in Fuschia, Pink, Red, Scarlet, White. **Zone 4**.



ROSA OSO EASY

$oldsymbol{\mathcal{N}}$ OSO EASY DOUBLE RED Rose -

A new easy-growing rose with an abundance of bright red, doubled blooms with orange undertones. This rose maintains a nice rounded habit and has excellent disease resistance. Grows 3-4' tall and wide. Zone 5.

OSO EASY ITAL-IAN ICE Rose-

Italian Ice's orange buds open to soft yellow flowers melting into pink blushed margins. The soft flower color is set off nicely by its dark green, glossy foliage. Flowers are semi-doubled. No spraying, no deadheading, just lots of flowers all

season long! Grows 18–30 inches tall and wide. Zone 4.

OSO EASY LEMON ZEST Rose-

Sunny, canary yellow flowers do not winners fade to white, and really light up against the glossy green foliage. Brilliant color and excellent diseaseresistance. Superior diseaseresistance makes it easy for gardeners to enjoy. Grows 24-36 inches tall and wide. Zone 4.







OSO EASY PAPRIKA Rose-

Starting out orange and fading to coral with a golden sun in the center. This beauty has the habit. flower color and disease resistance that any rose lover is looking for. This rose does not need to be sprayed like many other rose varieties. Grows 12 to 24 inches tall X 24-36 inches wide. Zone 3.

RUGOSA ROSES

Rugosa roses are among the toughest of garden roses. They are dense and robust in form, very thorny, and the leaves are thick and heavily veined. Plump rose hips appear following the bloom period in spring and foliage turns an attractive bronze color in the fall. Rugosas make wonderful hedges and look good in a mixed shrub border. Rugosas are very hardy and disease resistant.

Rosa 'Hansa' - Double magenta pink flowers with wrinkled green leaves. Flowers strongly fragrant. Naturalizes well. Use for effective mass plantings or privacy barriers. Grows 4-6 high with equal spread. **Zone 3.**





Rosa 'Snow Pavement' Fragrant, blush-white, double flowers bloom all summer on this low-growing, bushy rose shrub. Pavement roses are tough as well as beautiful. They are tolerant of extremes in temperature and will do well in full sun or partial shade. Grows 3-4' high with 3ft spread. Zone 3.

ROSA 'WOODSII'

Wood's Rose - Native Rose with single, light pink flowers. Good for naturalizing or as a bank planting. Grows 4 ft high with equal spread. **Zone 3**.



SALIX 'FLAMINGO'

Flamingo Dappled Willow -Hardy perennial shrub with spectacular deep red variegated foliage. The outer leaves turn a bright pink, while the inner leaves are areen and white. Fast growing and easy to care for, can be used as a superb accent and focal point in beds and borders, foundations plantings, alongside water features and naturalized areas. Great also as a container plant. 3 to 5ft high x 2 to 3ft wide Zone 4.



SALIX PURPUREA



JUNIPERUS CHINENSIS

GOLD COAST Juniper - Compact spreading form with golden yellow new growth. Color deepens in the cold weather. Graceful appearance. 3 ft high with 6 ft spread. Zone 4.



MINT JULEP Juniper -

Arching, fountain like form with mint green foliage. Will tolerate windy, dry, full sun exposure. 6 ft high with 8 ft spread.



JUNIPERUS HORIZONTALIS

BAR HARBOR Juniper -

Low growing blue-green foliage becoming purplish in the winter. Adapts to soil conditions from dry alkaline to wetter conditions. 1 ft high with 10 ft spread.

Zone 3.





BLUE CHIP Juniper - Evergreen groundcover with superb silver-blue foliage all year. One of the best blue ground cover junipers. Grows 8" high by 6' wide. Zone 3.

PRINCE OF WALES Juniper -

Low spreading evergreen with bright green foliage. Branches form starburst-like pattern displaying carpet of dense soft foliage. Fall color is purple-plum. Grows 8 in. tall X 10' spread. **Zone 3.**





ICEE BLUE Juniper - Low growing, spreading evergreen with intense silvery blue foliage forming a spectacular carpet of color. Excellent groundcover with tight mounding branches. Grows 6-8 in tall x 7 ft wide. Zone 3.

WILTONII Juniper - One of the finest trailing junipers having a uniform, full centered growth habit with intense silver-blue evergreen foliage. Grows 6inch tall X 6-8' wide. Zone 3.



JUNIPERUS SABINA

CALGARY CARPET Juniper - Soft

green foliage on a low spreading juniper. Forms a thick mat. Very popular for banks and mass plantings. 1 ft high with 10 ft spread. **Zone 3**.



MOONGLOW Juniper - Beautiful medium sized upright evergreen with a broad pyramidal shape. Intense blue foliage all year long. Grows 12 feet tall by 5 feet wide. Zone 3.



SKY-ROCKET Juniper -Columnar arowth habit with silver blue foliage. Fast grower to 15 ft high with 2-3ft spread. Zone 3.







WICHITA BLUE Juniper - A broad pyramid with bright blue-gray foliage. Upright growth habit. 12 ft high with 5 ft spread. Zone 3.



BLUE ARROW Juniper- An improved selection with tight, bright blue foliage and a very narrow, upright form. Perfect as a tall, narrow screen where space is limited. Makes a colorful evergreen addition to the garden. Grows 12'-15' tall X 2' wide. Zone 4.



PICEA ABIES



CUPRESSINA - Columnar Norway Spruce - Slender, uniform growth habit with dense branching to the ground. Dark green needles are slightly curved on closely set branches. Makes an ideal windbreak or privacy wall. Grows 20' tall X 5' wide. **Zone 2**.



NIDIFORMIS- NEST SPRUCE -Classic evergreen with broad, flat branch structure. Dark green needles. Not particular about soils. 3 ft high with 6 ft spread. **Zone 3**.

Pendula'- is unusual weeping and irregularly shaped evergreen whose form will vary considerably depending upon its early training. Unless staked and supported, it generally does not grow upward, but instead will mostly spread along the ground. It can be a very unique specimen in the landscape, particularly if located in a spot where its form can be best utilized. If staked and supported, it can grow generally upright into a 10-15' tall tree. If left grows 3 ft high and 4-15 ft spread. Zone 3



PICEA PUNGENS



COLORADO SPRUCE- Green and Blue - Slow growing to 60 ft tall and 20 ft wide. Conical shape with stiff horizontal branching, becoming more open with age. Somewhat drought tolerant. **Zone 3.**

GLAUCA 'Fat Albert' Spruce - This Colorado spruce cultivar is noted for its dense, broad, upright pyramidal shape, closely-spaced, ascending branches and steel blue needle color. Grows slowly approximately (12"+ per year). Oblong cones (2-4" long) are greenish when young, maturing to light brown.



PINUS FLEXILIS

VANDERWOLF'S PYRAMID LIMBER

PINE- pyramid shaped pine with long, twisted silvery blue-green needles displayed on dense branches. Resistant to insects and disease. Evergreen. Grows 20' tall X 10-15' wide. **Zone 4.**



PINUS MUGO

MUGHUS - Mugo Pine -Useful in masses, foundation planting or in groupings. Medium to dark green foliage. Very tolerant of alkaline soil. 7 ft high with 10 ft spread. **Zone 2**.





PUMILIO - Dwarf Mugo Pine - Popular dwarf conifer displaying dark green needles on its shrubby habit of broadly spreading branches. Useful for rock gardens, mass plantings, and in groupings with broadleaf plants. Full sun. A slow grower to to 5ft tall, spreads to 6 to 10ft. **Zone 2.**

PINUS NIGRA

AUSTRIAN PINE - Broad spreading evergreen with ascending branch habit. Tolerates dry sites and alkaline soil. Grows 40-60 ft tall. **Zone 4**.



PSEUDOTSUGA MENZIESII

DOUGLAS FIR - A fast growing dense evergreen with soft needles and a pyramidical-shaped tree. Dark green foliage. Full sun. Grows to 60' tall X 30' wide. Zone 4.



TAXUS X MEDIA

HICKSII - Hick's Yew - An excellent evergreen shrub for tall hedges with dark green glossy, needle-like foliage and a narrow, columnar habit and bright red berries in fall . 12 ft tall with 5 ft spread.

THUJA OCCIDENTALIS



DE GROOT'S SPIRE Cedar - Narrow, strongly upright form of cedar. Scale-like evergreen foliage holds its color well throughout the winter. Fine small specimen or accent for landscapes of small size. Grows 8 ft tall x 2 ft wide. **Zone 3.**

EXCELSA OKANAGAN Red Ce-

dar - Excelsa is the fastest growing of the Thujas and is a tall conical tree. The bright green foliage turns bronze in winter. Excellent for a fast screen. Max height 20' with 5' - 8' spread. Cuttings selected from an 'Excelsa' hedge in South East Kelowna that has proven cold hardy and vigorous over the past 20 years. **Zone 5.**



Ornamental Grasses

COOL SEASON GRASSES

Grasses from cool climates come into growth in late winter and flower before mid-summer.

Last year's growth should be cut down as soon as the snow is gone.

CALAMAGROSTIS

X ACUTIFLORA 'KARL FOERSTER'- Feather Reed Grass – Tall slender green foliage that tolerates moist soil conditions. Plant in full sun in groupings or use as a background. 6-8 ft high, clump forming. **Zone 4**.



X ACUTIFLORA 'OVERDAM' - Variegated Reed Grass - White and green variegation and smaller in size making it more refined than 'Karl Foerster'. Does will in hot sum with ample moisture, but likes a little shade in hot climates. Grows 20 - 30 inches tall. Clump forming. Zone 3.

BRACHYTRICHA - Korean
Feather Reed Grass - This
showy new Feather Grass
comes into bloom in late summer or early fall, with fluffy
pink, aging to bronze flowering spikes. Very heat tolerant.
Grows 3ft high x 2ft wide.
Zone 4.



X ACUTIFLORA 'ELDORADO'-Variegated Feather Reed Grass Green leaves are variegated with bright yellow/gold midribs. Clump forming. Prefers full sun and well drained soil. Grows 4-5' tall X 2' wide. **Zone 4.**

CAREX MORROWII

ICE DANCE Japanese Sedge - Rhizomatous and carpet forming but not invasive, this Japanese Sedge is an excellent evergreen ground cover. Growing to around 1ft tall and spreading with bright green glossy blades that have a clean, cream-colored edge. An adaptable plant, but best in loose soils with some moisture and part shade. Deer resistant. Zone 5.





NORTHERN LIGHTS Tufted hair grassvariegated green and creamy white blades have a rosy pink color when emerging in early spring and again as the weather cools. Deer resistant and evergreen. Prefers filtered sun. Grows 1' tall and wide. **Zone 4**.

FESTUCA

BEYOND BLUE FESCUE - Valued for its clumping habit, This selection forms a dense tuft of bluer than blue leaves that remain blue all season. Excellent for mass planting, edging, Clumps are easily divided in early spring, and should be divided every 3 years. Grows 10–12 inches. **Zone 4.**



HELICTOTRICHON SEMPERVIRENS



Blue Oat Grass - Densely tufted, evergreen, perennial grass. Mound forming with tightly rolled gray-blue leaves. 3 ft high with 2 ft spread. Zone 4.

WARM SEASON GRASSES

Grasses from warm climates come into growth in late spring, flower after mid-summer and are usually cut back in late fall/early winter.

They are best planted or divided in late spring.

MACRA AUREOLA - Japanese Forest Grass. Vividly striped bright gold and lime-green foliage that holds its color throughout the season. When grown in full sun this cultivar often develops a slight reddish tinge. Grows 12-18 in. high and wide. **Zone 5.**



IMPERATA CYLINDRICA 'RED BARON'

Japanese Blood Grass - A great red tipped upright ornamental grass that becomes increasingly red as the season progresses. Becomes blood red by fall. It is useful in borders, rock gardens, containers or as a colorful accent. Likes well-drained and moist soils. 12-18" high x 24-36" wide.

MISCANTHUS 'GIGANTEUS'

Giant Chinese Silver Grass - Clump forming, very robust. Foliage is green, blade width is 1.25", grows up to 12 ft in height. Flowers September through frost, 12" above foliage. One outstanding quality this giant is lending a tropical effect to any landscape. Zone 4.



MISCANTHUS SINENSIS

PURPURASCENS - Flame Grass - Easily grown in average soil in full sun to light shade. Clump forming, reaching 4-5 ft tall and 3 ft wide. Spectacular late season bloomer-foliage turning bronze-orange with white plumes that persist through winter. **Zone 4.**



GRACILLIMUS - Maiden Grass - Long arching narrow green eaves, forming a large symmetrical clump. The best choice for formal plantings. Does not flower reliably in cooler, short season areas. Grows 4-6ft tall. Zone 5.





MALEPARTUS Maiden Grass - A very hardy variety with stems to 7-8ft high. Flowers are reddish in bud ageing silvery then to white. Can have good autumn color. **Zone 4.**

PANICUM VIRGATUM 'ROTSTRAHLBUSCH'

RED SWITCH GRASS - noted for its excellent burgundy-red fall color. It is a clump-forming, warm season grass which typically grows in an upright, vertical clump to 3' tall (to 5' when in flower).

PENNISETUM ALOPECUROIDES



Fountain Grass - Can develop into an imposing mound of gracefully arching foliage and flowers, but it is never invasive in colder climates. Warm season grass, clump forming, full sun to light shade. Foliage is green 3/8" wide, 2-3ft high. Flowers in August through September, 3-5 ft tall. Zone 4.

HAMELN - Dwarf Fountain Grass -Arching deep green foliage in an upright clump. Silver to pinkishwhite seed heads form in late summer. Compact growth 1.5-2.5 ft tall. Grows full sun to light shade.

Little Bunny - Miniature version of original species. Forms neat clumped mounds making it excellent for mass or border planting. Grows 12 inches high and 12 - 18 inches wide. **Zone 5**.

RED HEAD- Large mound of arching green leaves. Huge bottlebrush plumes in mid-late summer. Deep purple buds mature to smoky purple plumes. Grows 3'-4' tall X 2'-3' wide **7one 5**



PENNISETUM ORIENTALE

Oriental Fountain Grass - Delightful fluffy rose-pink flowers begin to appear in July and continue to form well into fall. A slowly spreading grass, it is a vigorous and reliable garden plant. Prefers well drained soil and full sun. Grows 3ft high with 2ft spread. **Zone 5.**

CAMPSIS RADICANS

RED TRUMPET Vine - Vigorous climber for sum or part shade. Attractive, ferny foliage and

showy clusters of large red trumpet flowers. Attractive to hummingbirds. Grows to 30 ft.

CELASTRUS SCANDENS

American Bittersweet - Woody climber. The small greenish-white or flowers are produced in June. The fruit is a orange-yellow capsule which opens in autumn, disclosing the scarlet-colored seed. Both male and female plants are needed to produce fruit. Climbing to 20 ft tall. Zone 3.



CLEMATIS JACKMANII

PINK MINK CLEMATIS- an abundance of bright pink-on-pink blooms from early summer to early fall. Best planted in full sun but keep roots cool with mulch. Grows 10 - 15 ft. Zone 4.

Climbing Hydrangea - Vigorous, woody, deciduous climber, clinging by aerial roots. Bears white fertile and sterile flowers in summer. Can grow to 50 ft high.

DROPMORE SCARLET Honeysuckle - Glossy green vine with scarlet, tubular shaped flowers from summer to fall. Prefers full sun. **Zone 3**.



PARTHENOCISSUS

QUINQUEFOLIA ENGELMANII – Engelman Ivy - Self clinging, vigorous, woody vine with glossy green leaves. Brilliant red autumn color. Grows to 30 ft high. Zone 3.



TRICUSPIDATA - Boston Ivy - Vigorous, woody, self clinging climber with bright green leaves that turn brilliant red to purple in autumn. 30 ft high. Excellent on brick walls.

Perennials

ALCHEMILLA MOLLIS

LADY'S MANTEL - Leaves are kidney shaped, and flowers are frothy clusters of greenish yellow that appear in early summer. The longlasting blooms are a soft, sensuous shade that blends remarkably well with a range of colors. Grows 18-24 in. high and wide. Zone 3.



ARTEMISIA

ARTEMISIA'SILVERMOUND' -

This non invasive Artemisia forms a perfect dome of densely cut, silvery grey, silky-haired leaves with insignificant flowers. Grows 10-12" tall and 12-23" wide. **Zone 3**.



ASTER

WOODS PURPLE Aster - Woods purple is compact in habit and has improved disease resistance. Small, semidouble, blue-violet to purple flowers with yellow centers bloom in late summer to early fall. Grows 12-18inches tall and wide. **Zone 4.**



ASTILBE

Red, Pink or White - Feathery flower plumes that make excellent dried flowers. Tolerates boggy soil and grows beautifully in shade. 24" tall. **Zone 3**.

BERGENIA CORDIFOLIA 'BRESSINGHAM RUBY'

HEARTLEAF Saxifrage - Distinctive heart shaped leathery leaves are thick and glossy. Forms an expanding yet not invasive clump. Excellent ruby red fall and winter foliage. Pink flowers in spring plus some fall re-bloom. Grows 12-15 inches tall X 18–24 inches wide. Zone 2.



BRUNNERA MACROPHYLLA 'JACK FROST'

Jack Frost Brunnera - Silver heart shaped leaves, edged with a green border and with green veining. Bright blue flowers in spring. Full shade. Grows 12" tall x 24" wide. **Zone 4.**



CAMPANULA CARPATICA

Bellflower - The plant forms a neat mound of light green foliage about a foot wide and 6-8 inches tall. Bell-shaped flowers are produced on thin, wiry stems from mid-summer to early fall. Full sun to partial shade in fertile, well-drained soil. Blue Clips and White Clips shown here. **Zone 3.**





COREOPSIS VERTICILLATA 'MOONBEAM'

MOONBEAM Tickseed - Clusters of light yellow, daisy-like blooms and green airy fernlike foliage. Moonbeam blooms from June through October. Mildew resistant, drought tolerant. Needs well drained soil and full sun. Grows 24" high and 18-24" wide. Zone 4.



DELOSPERMA

FIRE SPINNER ICE Plant— Amazing tricolored flowers cover a tight, fast spreading mat of succulent evergreen foliage. Covered in spring blooms, reblooming throughout summer. Drought tolerant. Grows 2inch tall X 12-18 inches wide.

ECHINACEA PURPUREA

MAGNUS - Purple Coneflower

- Exceptionally large flowers with petals held more horizontally than other coneflowers. Grows 2 ft wide and up to 3 ft tall on strong stems and blooms from July until October. Zone 3.



HIDCOTE Blue Lavender - Best color of all Lavenders. Strong spikes of lavender blue flowers in summer above silvery grey-green foliage. Grows 15-18" tall. **Zone 5**.

Blooms first year. Deepest purple-blue color without bleaching. Strong branching. Highly scented. Grows 10-12 inches.

MUNSTEAD Lavender - Compact and early flowering. This is a fragrant robust lavender and, due to its short size and tightly held blooms, makes a great hedge. Grows 12 - 18 inches. **Zone 5.**

GREEN SHEEN Japanese Spurge -Excellent ground cover for shady areas. Attractive stems with extremely glossy bright green leaves. Will provide ground cover under pine trees. A slow spreader and grows 8-10 inches tall. Zone 3.

CREEPING PHLOX- A carpet of flowers, excellent for a groundcover or accent, perfect for banks, tolerates some drought once established. Evergreen foliage. Grows 6 inches tall X 3' wide. **Zone 3.**

Woolly Thyme - A ground cover with woolly gray-green foliage. Excellent for use between flagstones or in a rock garden. Tiny pink flowers bloom in late spring. Grows half inch tall and will spread 3 ft. Zone 5.

ELFIN Creeping Thyme - Dainty silver -green foliage adds character to rock gardens, and provides an interesting texture to pathways; small pink blooms appear in late spring. Grows to 4in. high X 8in wide. **Zone 3.**

VERONICA SPICATA 'ROYAL CANDLES'

DWARF SPIKE SPEEDWELL -

Forms a low bushy mound of dark green leaves, bearing short spikes of bright blue flowers in early summer for several weeks. A vigorous upright grower. Grows 15-18 inches high X 15 inches wide. **Zone 4.**



VERONICA SPICATA 'RED FOX'

RED FOX Speedwell - A most charming veronica. It has lance shaped, glossy, deep green leaves and upright, rosepink flower spikes that bloom throughout summer. Grows 12-18" tall. Zone 3.




VINCA MINOR

Periwinkle - Lavender blue flowers bloom on this evergreen ground cover in May or June. Performs best in rich, evenly moist, well drained soil and prefers part sun to shade. Grows 6 inches tall and spreads up to 3 ft. Zone 4.
